Importance of learning by doing (technical and IT aspects)

Lack of information from the recipient perspective

Missing information on financial support mobilized through public intervention

Lack of consistency and comparability of information



## **Opportunities: Reporting on support in BTR**

Standardized formats should lead to more clarity, comparability and consistency of information

Reporting parameters/provisions should lead to provision of greater granularity of information

Building on existing experience on what has worked well and where capacity building needed
