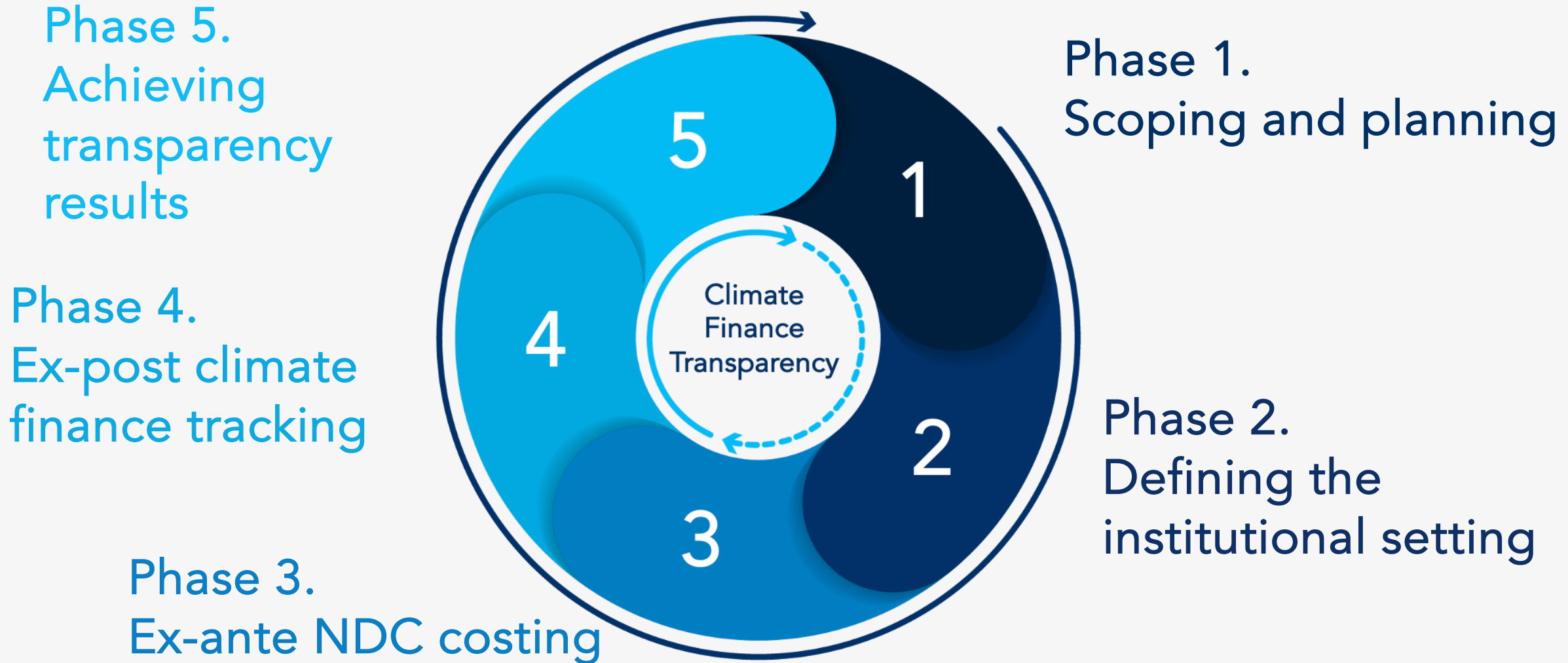

# The Climate Finance Transparency Framework



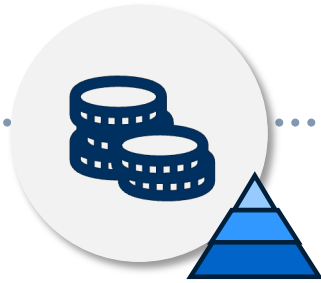

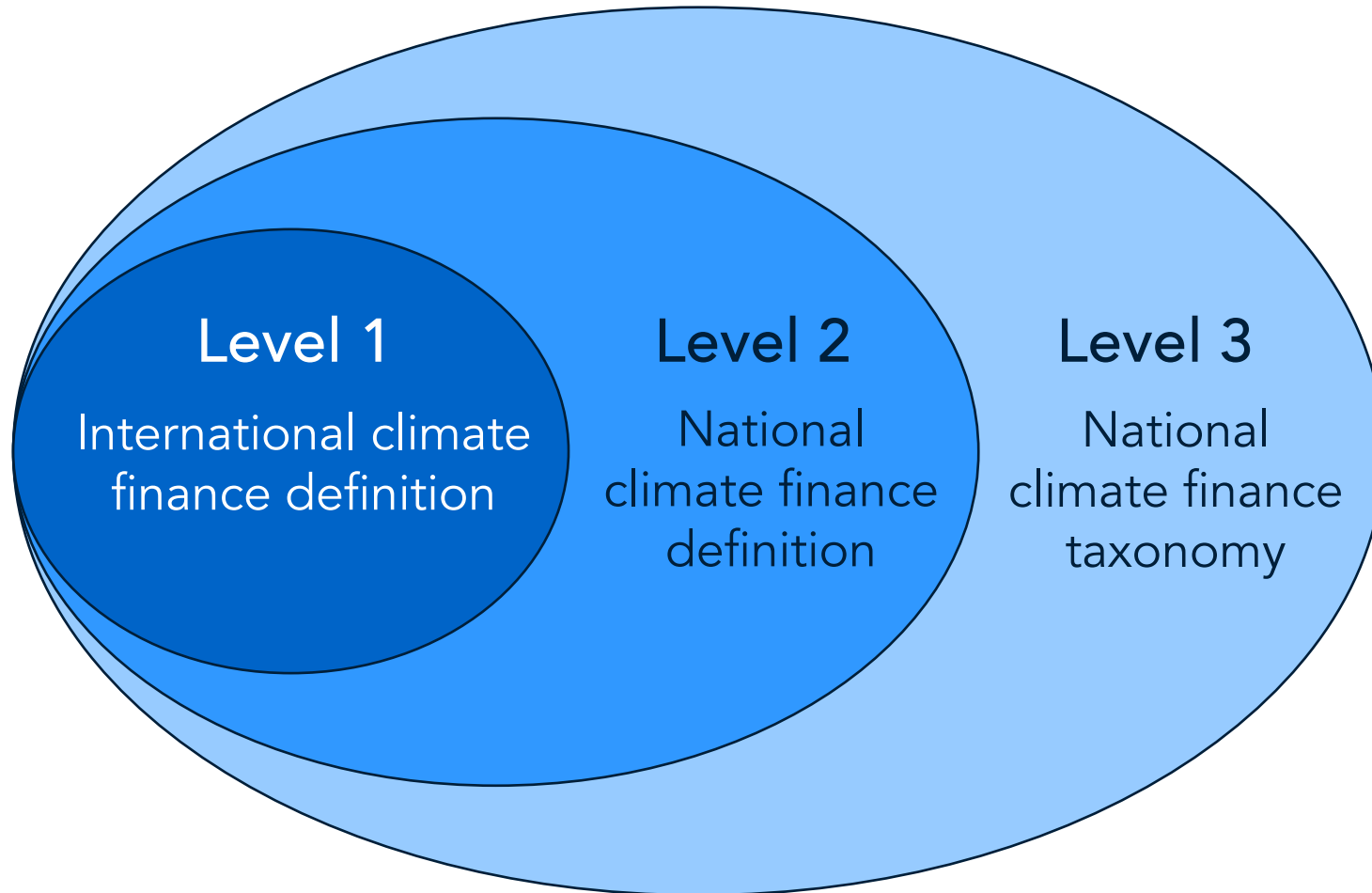

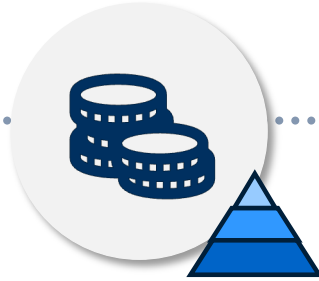
