I am writing to invite you to attend the CDKN UNFCCC side event *Climate Compatible Development, From Theory to Practice-What Works and Why*?

CDKN's mission is to support decision makers in developing countries to design and deliver climate compatible development (CCD) policies and practices. CDKN has defined CCD as "*development that minimise the harm caused by climate impacts, whilst maximising the many human development opportunities presented by a low emissions, more resilient, future*" (Mitchell & Maxwell, 2010). CCD is complementary, and directly links, to green growth and low emissions development (LEDS) approaches.

## Event focus:

The CDKN side event will tackle the following queries:

- How is CCD being applied in practice?
- Over and above the usual development challenges, what are the specific challenges and uncertainties that arise from seeking to apply CCD in practice?
- Can the triple-win CCD "sweet spot" (strategies which result in lower emissions, enhanced resilience and development) be achieved or is it in fact a balancing act?

During the event the panel will share examples and experiences and open these questions up for wider discussion. Each speaker will speak on one of the following themes.

v. Launch of the Climate Finance Advisory Service (CFAS): Ari Huhtala, Director of Programmes and Policy, CDKN
