Aims of CBIT (paragraph 85)

- 1 To strengthen national institutions for transparency-related activities in line with national priorities;
- 2 To provide relevant tools, training and assistance for meeting the provisions stipulated in Article 13 of the Agreement;
- 3 To assist in the improvement of transparency over time.

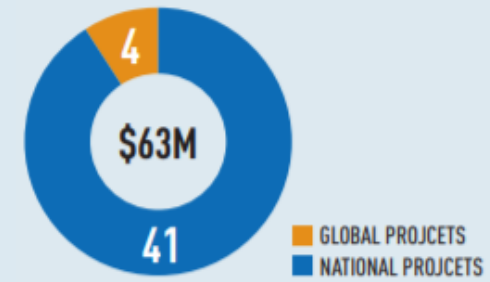
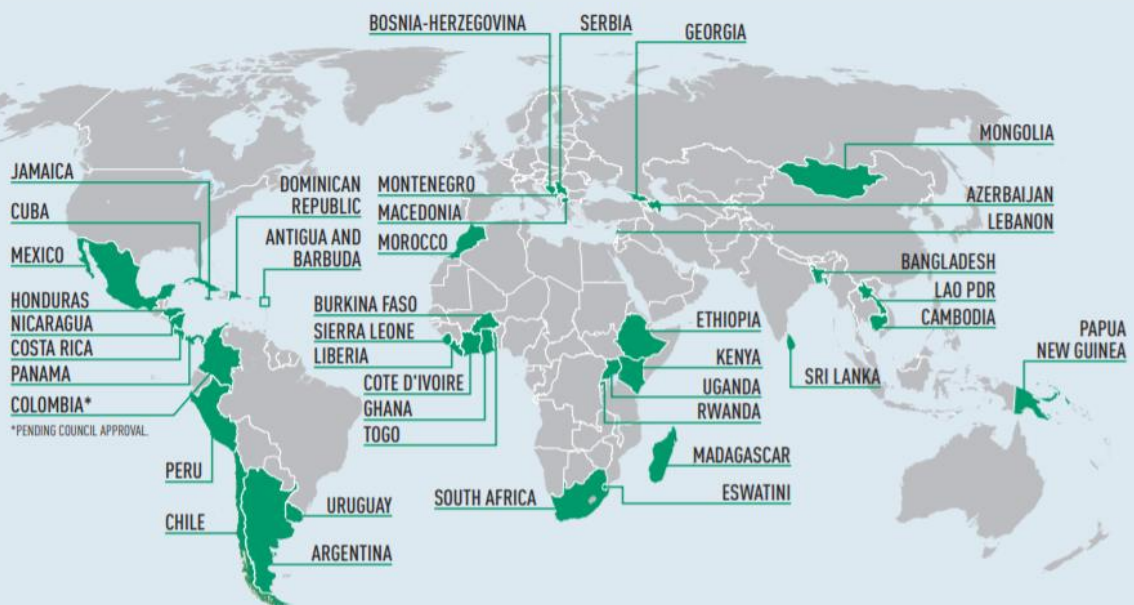


Programming Strategy

Capacity-building Initiative for Transparency (CBIT) Programming Status as of December 1, 2018



- ❑ 11 Least Developed Countries (LDCs) and 5 Small Island Developing States (SIDS)
- ❑ 13 projects have begun implementation
- ❑ 26% of non-Annex I Parties supported to date, representing 11% of total non-Annex 1 GHG emissions
- ❑ 4 global projects aim to improve knowledge sharing, coordination and facilitate additional capacity-building
- ❑ 5 agencies involved to date: Conservation International, FAO, IDB, UNEP and UNDP
