

# Country Needs Assessment Governance and Safeguard Findings

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#### **COUNTRY NEEDS ASSESMENT**

- Joint UN-REDD/FCPF initiative
- Focus:
  - Readiness needs in accordance with the <u>UNFCCC decisions</u> and the <u>harmonized R-PPs templates</u>
  - Assessment of technical, institutional and financial needs of countries in completing <u>phases I and II of REDD+</u>
- Key indicative capacity needs distilled from literature and expert knowledge
- 22 countries surveyed
- 6 countries visited (Cambodia, Colombia, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Ecuador, Papua New Guinea and Tanzania)
- Results offer a good view of the country priorities and of the evolving REDD+ landscape

### UN-REDD Support to REDD+ Governance and Safeguards

- Tailored technical assistance to countries on the policy, legal, administrative and operational aspects of tenure
- Legal advisory services to assist countries in developing robust legal frameworks for REDD+ (including carbon rights)
- Support to corruption risk assessments and anticorruption capacity and action plans
- Analysis and identification of institutional strengthening through the Participatory Governance Assessment (PGA)

### UN-REDD Support to REDD+ Governance and Safeguards

- Stakeholder Engagement and Free, Prior and Informed Consent (FPIC) guidelines
- Support to stakeholders to engage in and influence national and international REDD+ processes
- Country approach to safeguards based on the UNFCCC decisions
  - Country driven support to addressing and respecting safeguards and to building the national information systems
