







Still keeping 1.5 °C alive

Saturday 12 th November 16:45 – 18:15 h. Room Tutankhamun

[Theme] Global carbon budgets consistent with the Paris temperature goal are small and rapidly depleted. In this side event we will present different proposals at the international, national and local levels for an urgent and fair climate action.

Long explanation

The remaining global carbon budget, or amount of carbon dioxide that can be emitted into the atmosphere to limit the temperature increase to below 1.5°C (with a 66% probability) is about 400 GtCO₂, which means that, at the current rate of carbon emissions per year, that budget will be exhausted in the next decade.

In this context, no matter that we place carbon neutrality in 2050, if we do not initiate drastic emissions reduction from now on. If we postpone action until 2030, we will never achieve the temperature stabilization target.

In this side event the Group of Governance on Climate Change of Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya will present a proposal to distribute the global carbon budget with equity criteria. The model of distribution has been carried out considering the four dimensions of equity: equality, capacity, responsibility and the right to sustainable development. This model has been used to assess, in the light of equity, the net-zero emissions pledges presented by some countries in their Long-Term Low Greenhouse Gas Emission Development Strategies.

Then the Climate Scorecard Project will present their effort to develop new proxy indicators to measure progress in reducing emissions in leading greenhouse gas emitting countries.

Finally, Asociación Proteger will explain real showcases, in Misiones (Argentina), of affordable, aspired and locally accessible building solutions improving living conditions.
