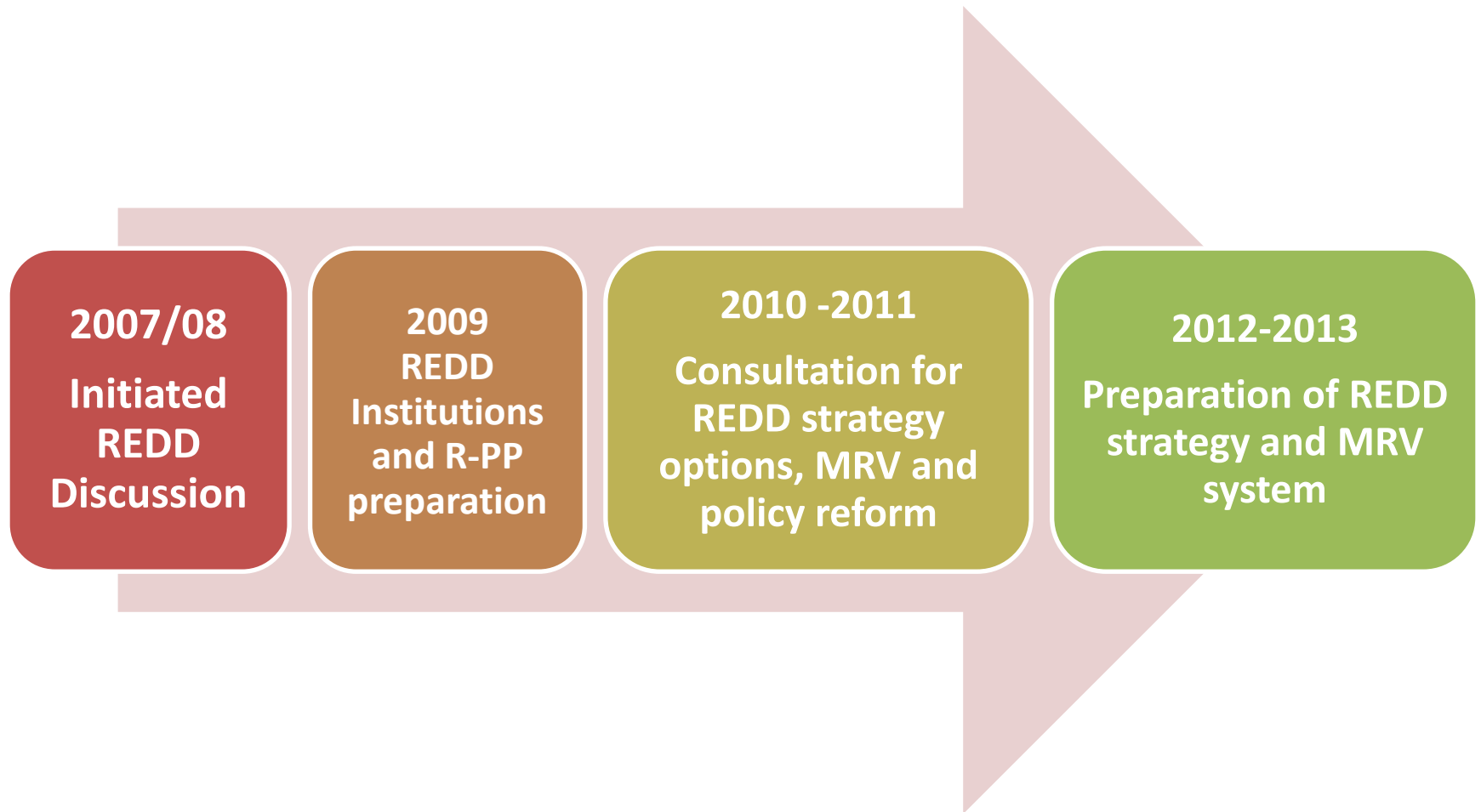

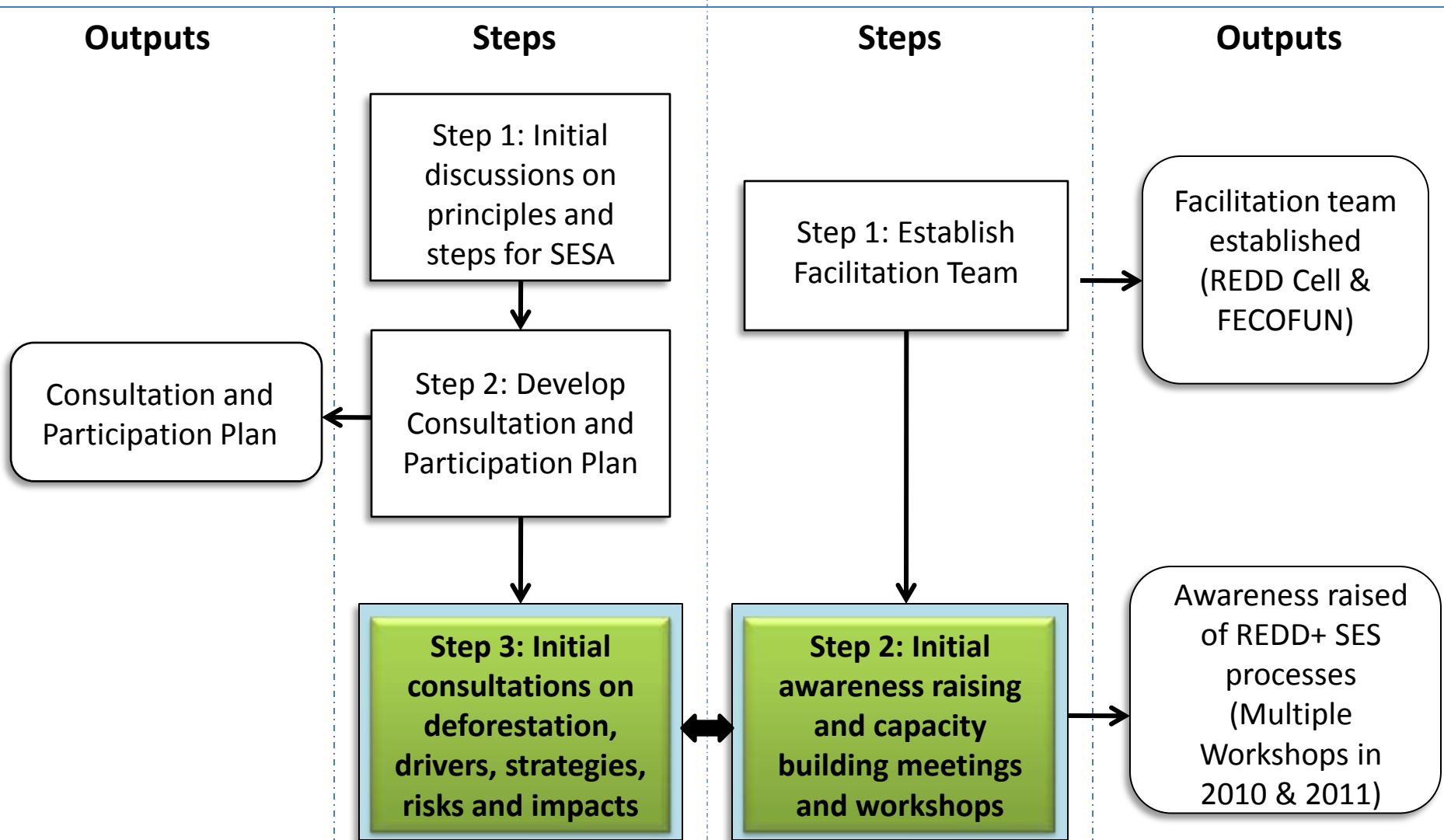

- 4. Support to develop synergy between safeguards initiatives at country level**

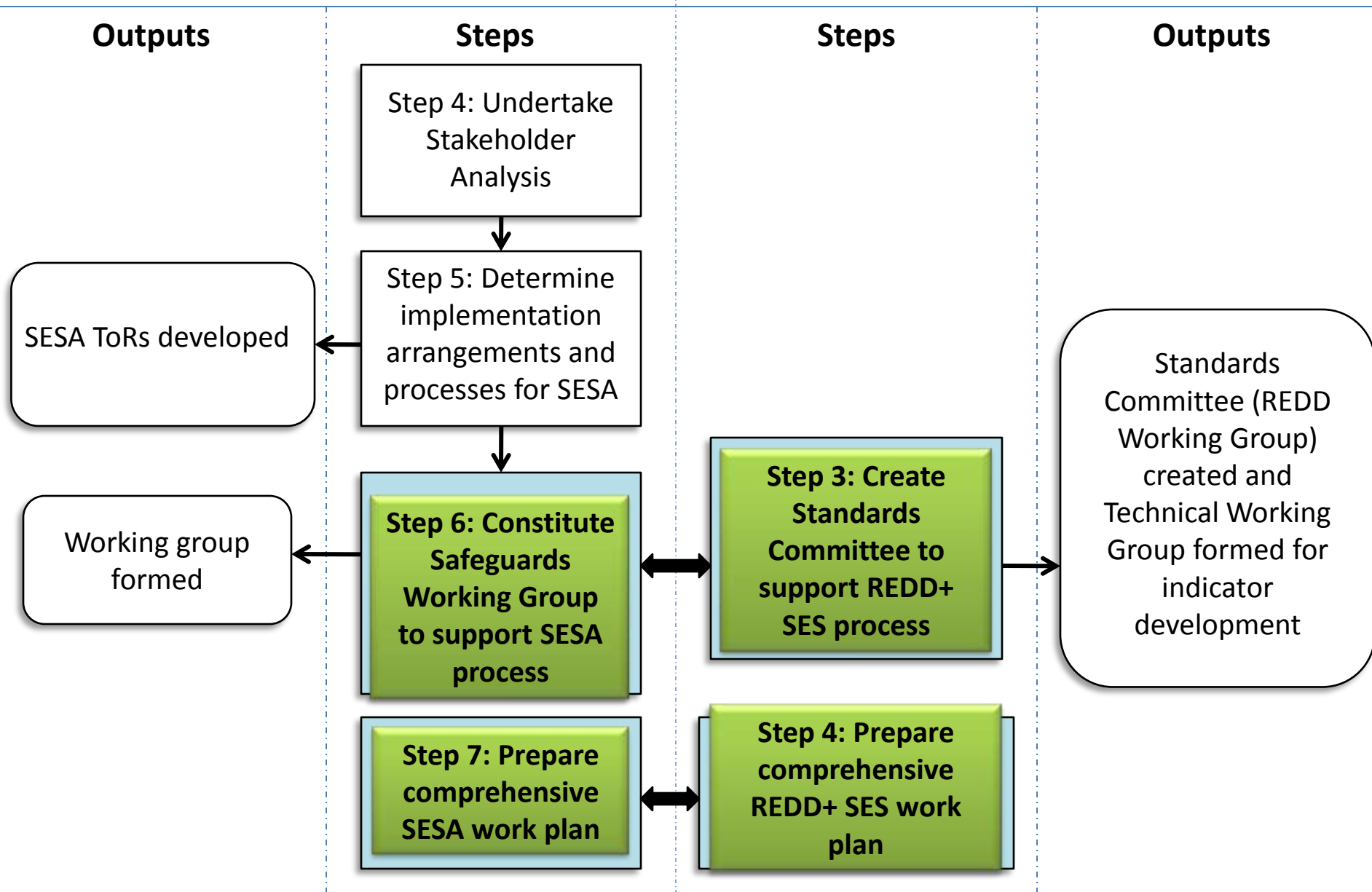

Challenges & Opportunities

Challenges

- Steps for the combination between REDD+SES and FCPF SESA-ESMF have been identified but using multiple safeguards initiatives creates challenges of coordination and slows down the process
- Implementation requires significant financial resources and technical support
- There are high expectations of stakeholders and it is difficult to fulfill all the demands and interests.

Opportunities

- Helps to provide a forum for discussion and build consensus on safeguards across an ethnically diverse country - Nepal
- Helps to develop a monitoring framework for preparation of a national safeguards assessment report
