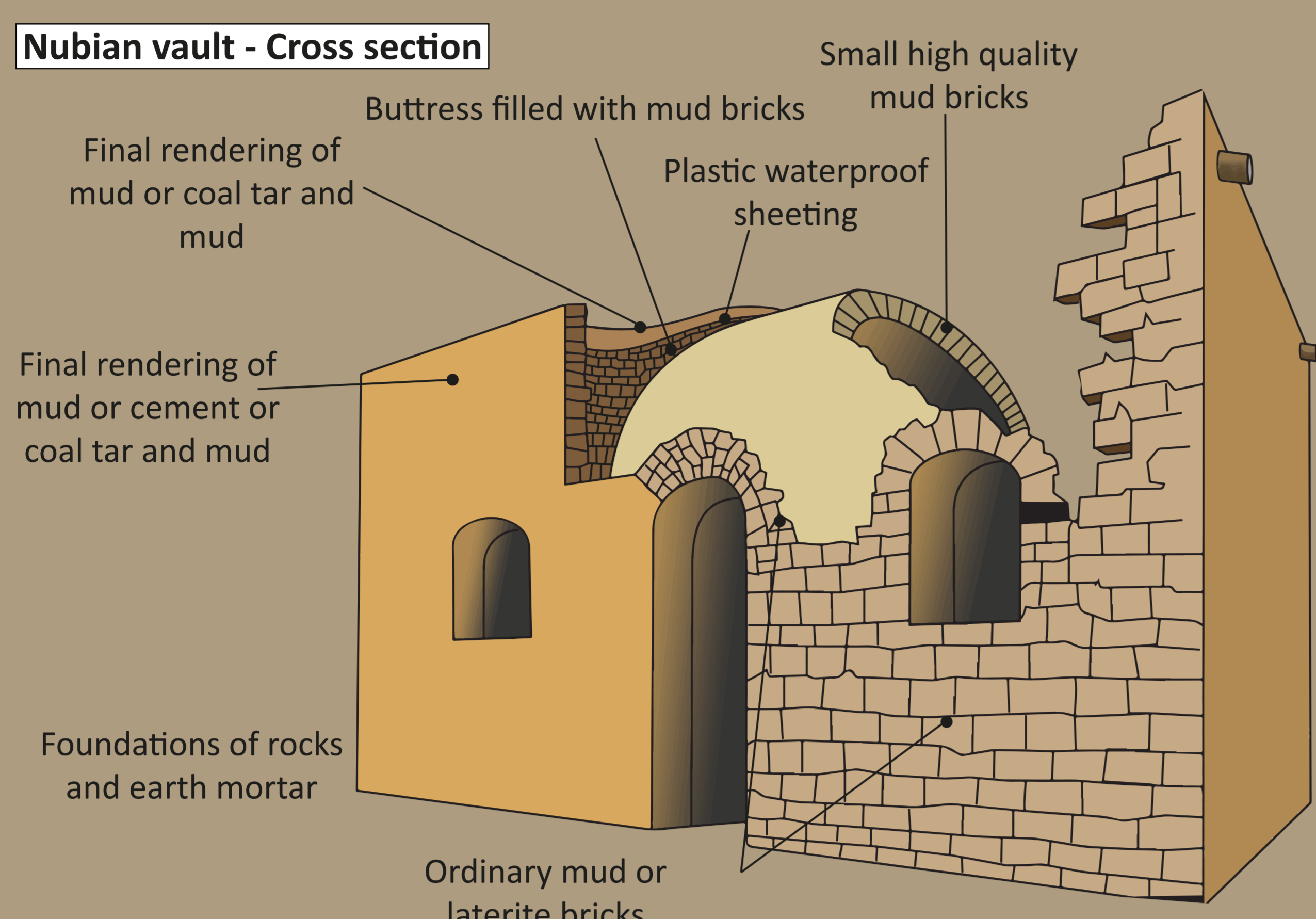




« An appropriate and sustainable response to the housing challenge in Africa »

Results and growth of AVN's program (2015)

- 1,500 building sites representing 67,500 square meters
- 5 countries: Burkina Faso, Mali, Senegal, Benin, Ghana
- 400 NV masons trained and 300 apprentices in training
- 20,000 direct beneficiaries (NV clients)
- 6 millions euros of local economies generated
- 55,000 tons of avoidable CO2 (structural work, energy savings)
- 30% of annual market growth
