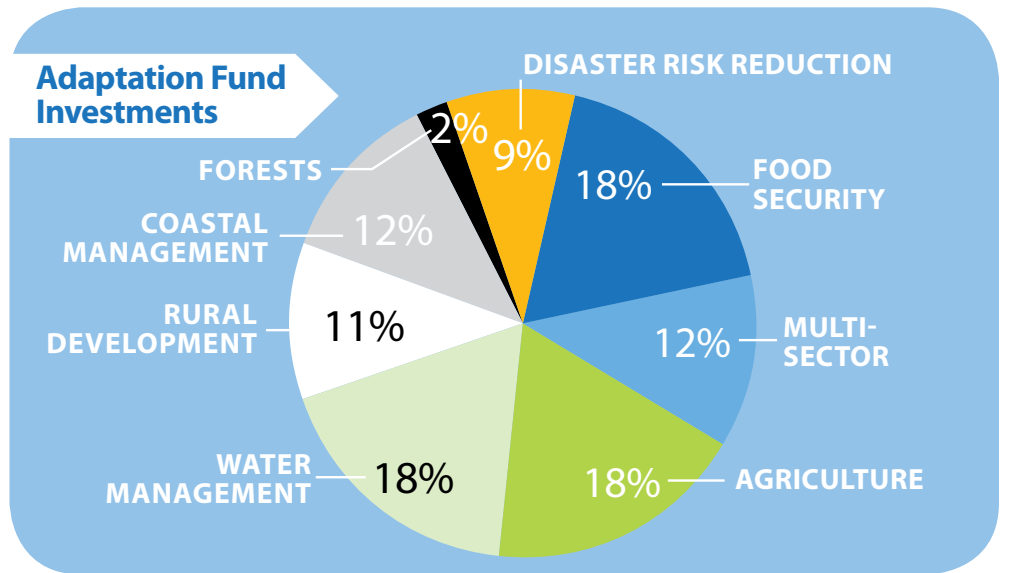

AF ROADMAP TO SERVE PARIS AGREEMENT

- Roadmap established by COP21
- Adaptation Fund May Serve Paris Agreement, subject to process that is already underway
