# **African Development Bank**


Key areas of intervention:


- at the country level, three broad sectoral themes

- · cross-cutting issues: environment and gender



- Zambia/Tanzania/Kenya interconnect (± €275M)
- Lesotho Utility Services Access (± € 12M)

#### 2007

- Madagascar micro hydro (± € 18M)
- Nigeria Niger interconnection (± €24M)


#### **FINESSE** program


- Mainstreaming renewable energy and energy efficiency in Bank's activities
