Heidelberg Building Standard 1992 and 2005 (technical standard 30% lower national standard)

Examples:

- 5L -Low energy houses 1992 50% better than legal standard,
- 2L Passive-house standard since 2005, sportsgym and world first firebrigarde

- 750 Euro units VHS
