Background

Mandated as an operating entity of the Financial Mechanism to serve the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change and the Paris Agreement, the Green Climate Fund (GCF) supports the implementation of developing countries' Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) as an important reference point to the Fund's programming. The Fund also intends to become a key channel through which a substantial share of the USD 100 billion per year to be mobilized by developed country Parties are directed, in particular in relation to adaptation.

On 20th October 2018, the GCF Board launched the first replenishment process of the Fund. This event, therefore, aims to provide a snapshot of the Fund's performance to date and discuss key priorities to accelerate climate finance to match the ambition and urgency needed to meet the climate challenge. The event will also focus on GCF's role in mobilizing resources and driving impact at scale for the successful implementation of the Paris Agreement.

Hosted by the Co-Chairs of the Board and the Executive Director a.i. of the GCF Secretariat, this event brings together high-level representatives of developed and developing country parties and accredited entities. Both speakers and participants will have an opportunity to engage in interactive exchanges.
