





## Invitation to side event

Implementing Nationally Determined Contributions: Importance of Technology and Capacity Building

This COP-22 side event, organized jointly by Swaziland and the UNEP DTU Partnership, discusses capacity development, finance and technology support to countries in implementing Nationally Determined Contributions, focusing on opportunities and challenges ahead.

With the Paris Agreement being based on contributions by all countries and providing a clear roadmap for further strengthening ambition under the agreement, the context for national action has fundamentally changed. The Nationally Determined Contributions will need to be fully integrated in national development plans and envisaged action need to move towards implementation. Most developing countries have made contributions partly voluntary and partly conditional where the conditional parts depend on finance, technology and capacity support. The fundamental context for capacity building support has therefore changed from being time bound and product focused to being long term and institutions focused. Strong partnerships around technology, finance & capacity building are therefore needed.
