Session Overview

- The NAMA registry is a public online platform, developed by the UNFCCC secretariat in 2013. It aims at expediting implementation of mitigation actions in developing countries.
- The interim NDC registry, deployed in May 2016, allows countries to record their first NDCs in accordance with the Paris Agreement.
- This event primarily focuses to provide updated information on operation of NAMA and NDC registries in 2016.
- This event also aims to facilitate discussion on how NAMAs can play a prominent role on converting NDCs into tangible, ambitious and implementable mitigation policies, programs and actions.
