### Modelling the Blue Recovery Bond



-Fishing Companies - Net cash flow impact from fish bond (USDmn, rhs)

 USD 7bn investment over 5 years

- Fish populations growth up by 3.5%
- IRR: 26% for investors, 57% for fishing companies
- Fishing companies better off after 8 years

Conclusion

- Nature-based finance: very promising
- Policymakers should support nature-based instruments
- Transaction costs (e.g. monitoring) are high but will decrease
- Scalability and replicability are key
