This event will highlight the critical role of land tenure in strengthening countries' Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs), showcasing how securing land rights for Indigenous Peoples, local communities, and women can enhance climate action strategies.

This side event dialogue aims to:

1. Deepen participants' understanding of the importance of integrating land rights into the NDCs.
2. Demonstrate the importance of making land rights gender and socially equitable and inclusive for sustainable development and climate justice.
3. Deepen participants' understanding on how to make land rights more gender and socially equitable and inclusive for sustainable development and climate justice.
4. Promote meaningful inclusion of Indigenous Peoples, girls, youth, and other historically excluded groups in land rights decisions within the NDCs.
5. Issue a call to action for governments to incorporate land rights into their NDCs and for funders to provide financial support for this effort.
