Regional, state and local governments are developing their own global warming initiatives to reduce emissions from significant GHG emissions sources, such as automobiles and power plants. For example, the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI or "ReGGie") is a cooperative effort by seven Northeast and Mid-Atlantic states to discuss the design of a regional cap-and-trade program initially covering CO<sub>2</sub> emissions from power plants in the region. In the future, RGGI may be extended to include other sources of GHG emissions, and GHGs other than CO<sub>2</sub>. In California, where transportation is the largest contributor of CO<sub>2</sub>, emissions regulations have been proposed to control GHGs from passenger cars and light-duty trucks beginning with the 2009 model year.

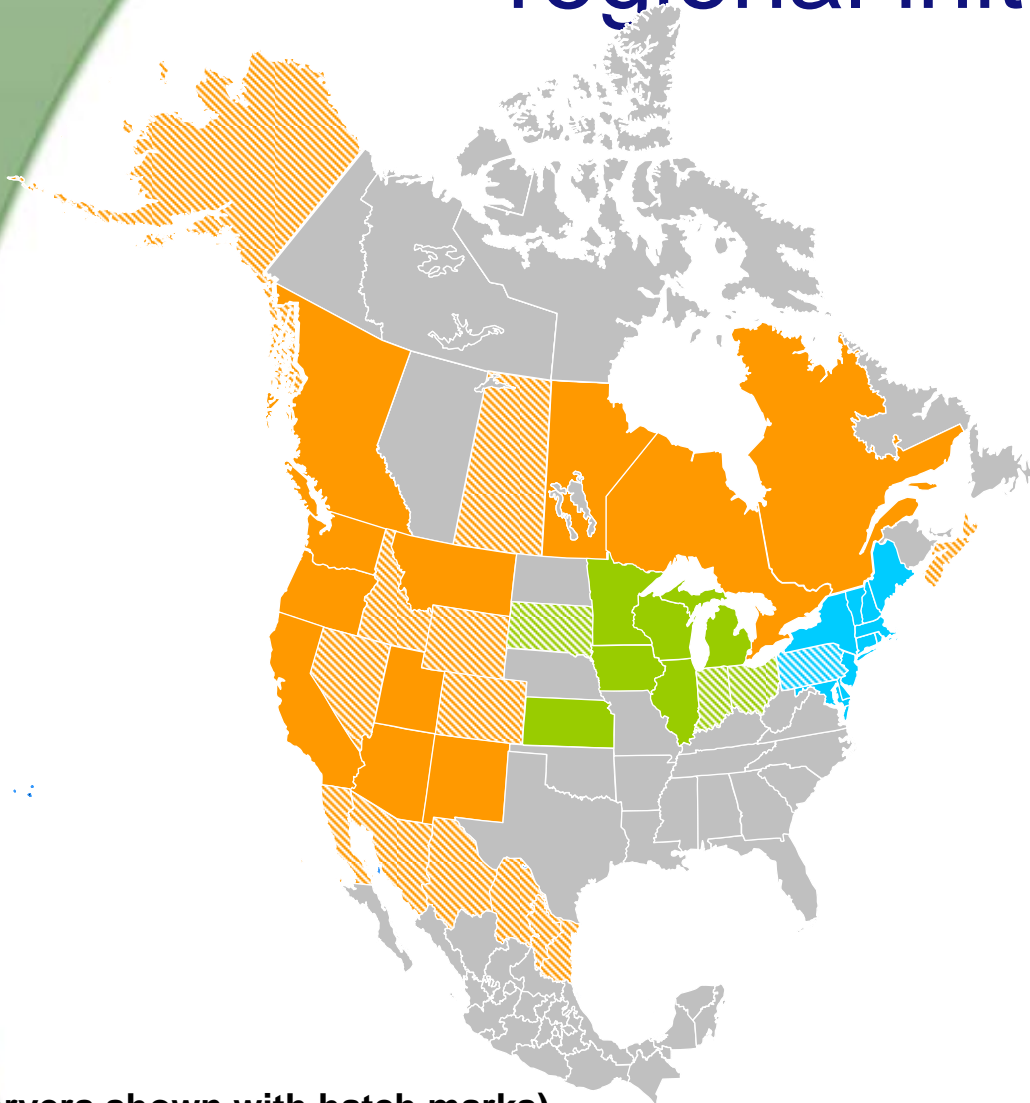
