No action to prevent REDD+ crime

Safeguards – what's needed?

 Monitoring, reporting & verification of safeguards in Cancun Decision

Develop guidance based on experience & lessons learned

Safeguards in Partnership Priorities

- Identify lessons, gaps & needs
- Act on basis of findings
- Fund appropriate capacity building

Enforcement

- Inform & engage enforcement community NOW
- Learn lessons from experience with environmental crime
- Coordinate with FLEG community
