Learn how NGOs in three parts of Africa, in India, in Nepal, and in Caucasus are reducing poverty with local, renewable energy solutions. Solutions that are also reducing greenhouse gases from the households that benefits from the solutions. Emissions are reduced with reduced coal use, reduced biomass use that reduces deforestation, and with biogas plants that reduce methane emissions from manure. The activities are earning greenhouse gas credits, but are struggling with the CDM rules. Therefore is proposed and discussed simplified CDM for small projects.
