





The Cameroon Pilot Project

Regional, national and sub-national REDD activities



Overview







Cameroon has been actively pursuing REDD Pilot activities since 2007 and has made progress in terms of technical and organisational developments for the implementation of REDD. The Ministry of Environment and Nature Protection (MINEP) in collaboration with the Ministry of Forestry and Wildlife (MINFOF) are co-ordinating REDD activities nationally. The side event has the overall objective to present the overall status and results of Cameroon's REDD activities which are linked to regional level programmes, as well as the progress on the national and sub-national projects. The key issues that will be presented include the National position on REDD and the activities that have been undertaken at a national level to implement a REDD institutional framework as well as the development of technical processes to support the programme. The technical developments and achievements which are embedded in a REDD Pilot Project will also be highlighted with special focus on the application of earth observation (EO) for assessment of deforestation rates, and methodologies for carbon stock estimation; the latter development was a result of South-South co-operation between Bolivia and Cameroon.
