


- Definition "Climate Service":

- Report of the high-level Taskforce for the Global Framework for Climate Services (WMO-No. 1085)







The German Climate Research Landscape







Examples –Hydrology (1/3)

- → Federal Institute of Hydrology (BfG)
- → Water levels data from selected gauging stations on German federal waterways
 - → service for the general public
 - → for commercial or private use
 - → data have not been plausibility-checked.








Examples – Hydrology (2/3)

→ Federal Institute of Hydrology (BfG)


→ Observed water levels of past 31 days, un-checked data

→ Each federal state is responsible for issuing hydrological warnings





Examples - Environment

- → Federal Environment Agency (UBA)
 - Competence Centre on Climate Impact and Adaptation (KomPass)
 - → coordination of national adaptation strategy
 - → German Emissions Trading Authority (DEHSt): the competent national authority to implement the market instruments of the Kyoto Protocol











The German Heat-health Warning System (HHWS)

- Deutscher Wetterdienst (DWD)
- Scientific Challenge
 - Identify a heat load indicator that is related to human health impacts,
 - and a threshold to trigger intervention actions
 - → Link meteorological statistics with the mortality data
 - Estimate excess mortality as a function of the heat load
 - Avoid warning-fatigue due to too frequent warnings








HHWS (2)

Operational Issues

- Warnings issued for all rural and urban districts (295 + 110) across Germany during warm season (~May to September)
- → 6 different altitude categories
- following the general warning strategy of DWD
- also accessible via the multilingual Meteoalarm platform







HHWS (3)

→ Administrative Challenges

- → Activities of the DWD are based on the national Law on the Deutscher Wetterdienst
- → Duties §4(1)1: "the provision of meteorological services for the general public or for individual customers and users, especially in the fields of ..., public health, ..."
- → Remuneration §6(2): "The Deutscher Wetterdienst shall charge a remuneration for the provision of its services."
- → The aim was to provide the HHWS free of charge
- → HHWS is now an essential product and part of DWD's Global Data Set (GDS)





HHWS (4)

- Administrative Challenges (cont.)
 - → Federal structure of Germany
 - → taking action is the responsibility of the Laender
 - → Public health intervention has to be triggered by the health system of the Laender
 - → Negotiate cooperation agreements with all 16 Laender individually
 - → DWD can only influence the effectiveness of the meteorological component of the HHWS
 - → Distribution of the warnings through DWD's newsletter system
 - → A few interfaces in the Laender, who are responsible for further distribution, receive the warnings still via fax
