



### **CDM Institution**

- Cambodia ratified the UNFCCC in December 1995 and acceded to the Kyoto Protocol in July 2002.
- The Ministry of Environment (MoE) was appointed as the Designated National Authority (DNA) for CDM in Cambodia, by subdecree.
- Cambodian Climate Change Office, Ministry of Environment, was established in 2003 to coordinate climate change related activities in Cambodia and acts as the DNA Secretariat.

#### Proposal for CDM Reform

#### **Current CDM issues for LDCs:**

- The CDM rules e.g., methodology, validation, verification and registration processes are a compromise: "one size fits all countries" (both large emerging economic countries, LDCs etc.)
- These rules are more adapted to developing countries with advanced economies, but not to Least Developed Countries
- The current rules of CDM are favour large projects with low transaction costs per ton of CER, which rearly take place in LDCs.

Two joined proposals between IGES and the Cambodian Climate Change Office (CCCO) have been made and submitted to the EB:

- IGES-CCCO Joint proposal regarding procedures for registration of CDM project activities in Least Developed Countries (LDCs):
  - Submitted to CDM EB in November 2007
  - Proposed 50% discounting the fee registration CDM projects in LDCs
  - Proposed half period of time for shortening registration the CDM projects in LDCs.
  - CDM EB abolished the fee for LDCs and we believe our proposal contributed to this changing.

#### Proposal for CDM Reform

- IGES-CCCO joint proposal regarding procedures for review of registration of CDM project activities in Least Developed Countries (LDCs)
  - Submitted to CDM EB in October 2008
  - Proposed to shorten procedures for review of registration in LDCs
  - When the CDM EB receives the comments from the DOE and project participants (PPs) one week before the first date of the next CDM EB meeting, the CDM EB will include prior consideration of this review in the agenda of the next meeting.
