Introduction

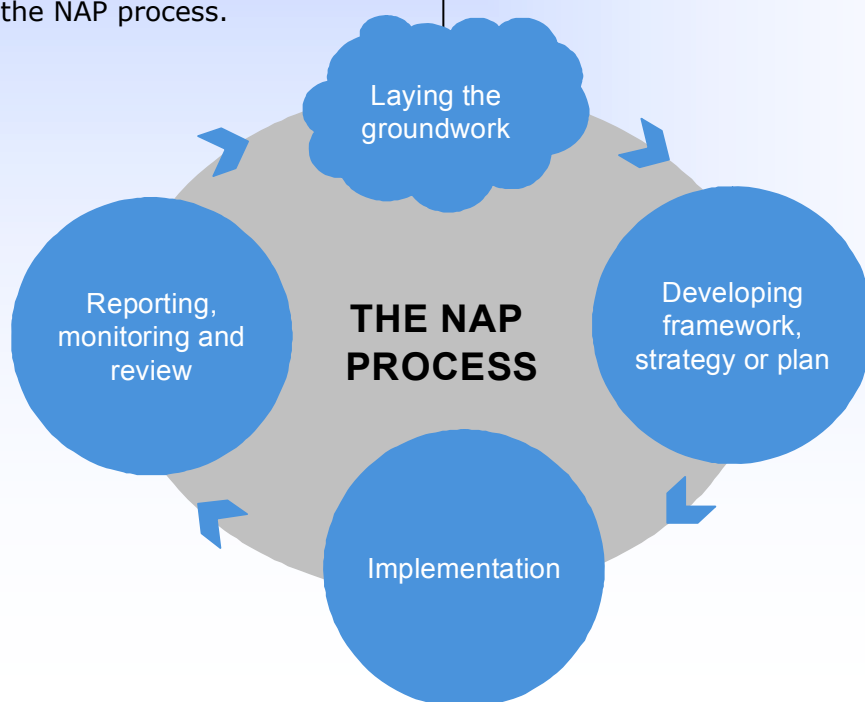
