Facilitating Negotiator Engagement

- UNEP support Parties in articulating their national and regional policy positions :
 - Long term engagement with the African Group through workshops and technical input by regional experts
 - Regional workshops in 2007 & 2008 Africa, Asia, Latin America, AOSIS and LDC.
 - > 90 countries participated in 2007 and around 130 in 2008
 - Target audience: lead negotiators from the Parties
 - ➤ All developing Non-Annex I Parties to UNFCCC



Facilitating Negotiator Engagement

OUTCOMES

- ✓ Sub-regional and regional preparatory workshops held to engage national climate change negotiators from all developing countries Parties
- ✓ Negotiating capacities and skill of participants substantially raised.
- ✓ National and regional policy positions defined and formulated with regard to national and regional priorities
- ✓ Policy positions brought to UNFCCC negotiation process

- Latin America Carbon Forum back to back with DNAs Forum and UNFCCC meeting – October 2008










Countries with CDM programs

• Assessments of Impacts of and Adaptation to Climate Change in Multiple Regions and Sectors (AIACC) supporting scientific capacity building and increased links between science and policy communities

NAPA support and follow up pilot programs

 Climate Change and Development – Adapting by REducing vulnerability - CC DARE. Flexible and targeted support to Sub Saharan African countries for integrating CC into development planning



Global Climate Change Adaptation Network

- New UNEP initiative to strengthen capacity at national and regional levels to support on-going and planned adaptation mainstreaming and implementation of specific activities.
- The Network aims to contribute specifically to:
 - -Nairobi Work Programme,
 - -NAPA follow up and implementation
 - -Assist countries on the integration of climate change issues into development planning and decision-making frameworks

- National communications partnering with UNDP
