## Sharing experience of recent long-term low emission development strategies (LTLEDS)

## Background

The Glasgow Climate Pact reemphasizes the urgent need to address the scale of the global climate challenge. It urged Parties that have not yet done so to communicate, by CMA4, long-term low greenhouse gas emission development strategies (LTLEDS) towards just transitions to net zero emissions by or around mid-century and regularly update, taking into account different national circumstances. It also invited Parties to update LTLEDS regularly, as appropriate, in line with the best available science. It further requested the secretariat to prepare a synthesis report on LTLEDS to be made available to CMA4.

51 LTLEDS, representing 60 Parties, were communicated to secretariat (as of 10 May) including 4 updated LTLEDS by 4 Parties. 10 Parties communicated LTLEDS during COP26 and 5 Parties thereafter.

## **Objective**

This session aims to facilitate preparation of LTLEDS by sharing experiences and key features of recent LTLEDS from different region. The participant will hear about challenges, opportunities and benefits of developing LTLEDS, such as how it drives short- and medium-term actions and resource mobilization, as policy-makers make efforts to achieve long term low GHG development that support sustainable and inclusive growth while ensuring a just transition.
