After ratification of the Paris Agreement, NDC implementation is becoming a focus in many countries. How can the day-to-day policy process of a rapidly developing country be made consistent with implementing increasingly ambitious NDCs? How can climate finance for conditional NDC components be mobilized, including from market mechanisms? How can policy instruments mobilize all the technologies needed for achieving the 1.5°C target? What role can key sectors such as forestry play?
