## Good environmental performance ...

... does not necessarily pay off in economic benefits





# To exploit the environmental advantage, politicians must create fair framework conditions



- Rail is the only mode of transport affected by the European emissions trading scheme
- Exemption from mineral oil tax and eco tax for airlines results in a cost advantage of EUR 395 million a year in Germany alone
- In contrast, DB AG pays nearly EUR 440 million in 2008 in mineral oil tax and eco tax, plus other energy and climate charges



### What needs to be done?





- A level playing field for all modes of transport needs to be established
- As a prerequisite for this, all modes of transport need to be included into the future climate treaty
- The flexible mechanisms have to be workable for the transport sector (e.g. programmes of activities)
- Emission trading or any other new instrument should not pose an additional burden on rail transport
- From a customer's view, environmental benefits should translate into economic benefits as well
