# GSP approach in enhancing MRV for ETF preparedness of developing countries

- Take stock of existing national arrangements for MRV
  - Ad-hoc national MRV arrangement
  - Basic national MRV arrangement
  - Well structured national MRV arrangement
- Gauge political will
  - General government awareness and support
  - MRV supported by policy, legislation, strategy, regulatory framework, decree
  - Intergovernmental interactions on climate change
  - Public consultations
- Hands on, sustained capacity building approach
  - Regional MRV Networks
  - Bilateral collaboration
  - In-country capacity building events


# Specific actions for ETF preparedness of developing countries

- Based on what will be reported, and is currently reported
  - GHG inventory
  - National communication
  - Climate change impacts and adaptation
- Based what will be reported, and is currently not a mandatory requirement
  - National Inventory Report (NIR) (shall)
  - Progress on implementing and achieving NDCs (shall)
- Based on what will happen in the international transparency
  - Technical expert review of GHG inventory information
- Preparation of guidance materials
  - Guidance material; e.g NDC implementation Guide
  - Peer review documents; e.f GHG inventory peer review guide
  - Generic TORs

# Key internal factors significant for preparedness of developing countries to implement ETF

- Regular interaction between MRV teams and all relevant institutions and other stakeholders
- National MRV systems to be structured in such a way that they support international reporting and meet national for well-founded decisions at the political level
- Need for clear and legal allocations of roles and areas of responsibility in the national climate MRV system
- Regular communication between MRV teams and higher government levels to get commitment / buy-in at the higher political level
- Sustainable national budgetary framework for climate change MRV
