# SPORTS AS A WAY OF ENGAGING AND EMPOWERING CITIZENS TO CLIMATE ACTIONS

Sports can make a major contribution to mitigating climate change by reducing its own carbon footprint, by impacting its supply chain and especially by engaging and empowering citizens to climate actions and introducing climate friendly ways of conduct. The event, organized jointly by Estonia and Climate Leadership Coalition (CLC), offers examples on how sports have already contributed and perspectives on what the opportunities for further actions are.

The role of citizens is critical in achieving the goals of the Paris Climate Agreement since the pledges of governments, cities, and global business sector are not yet enough. Recent studies state that on the global level, around 70% of greenhouse gas emissions are related to household consumption. Citizens should be engaged as the key drivers for the transformation.
