COP22 Call for Resources for Youth Climate Action

In the context of the UN Climate Change Conference COP22 the International Association for the Advancement of Innovative Approaches to Global Challenges IAAI is organizing with partners (CliMates, Youthink Center, CCEN, UNESCO MOST et al.) a resource mobilization campaign for youth climate action (hashtag #GiveYouthaChance).

The initiators of #GiveYouthaChance campaign are convinced that the **time is ripe for a large scale social movement towards resource mobilization for youth climate action**. COP22 will be an important milestone for setting up **transformative partnerships** for Paris agreement implementation and therefore a unique **opportunity for all those who have resources** and who are inclined to use them in a globally coordinated way to **empower young people to take meaningful and rewarding action on climate change**.

What?

The **#GiveYouthAChance COP22 Call for Resources** campaign **calls for resources**

- for youth participation in UNFCCC processes
- for UN system's programs on youth empowerment for climate action and
- for an Agenda2030 youth action marketplace that will empower young people for local climate action in a globally coordinated manner and connect them with blended financing from local and global public, private and philanthropic sources.

The campaign consist of

- a crowdfunding component that is targeting small donations of ordinary global citizens (please visit <u>https://www.razoo.com/us/story/Glocha-Global-</u> <u>Challenges-Foundation-New-York/related causes</u> for details) and
- a "<u>Global Challenges Giving Pledge</u>" call and registry for philanthropists and public and private institutional wealth holders.

The short term **fundraising target** of the campaign is **1 million Euro** (or 1,1 mio US\$) which shall be achieved before the end of January 2017 (to be reported at ECOSOC Youth Forum 2017) and a long-term fundraising goal of 100 million for which the time plan will be elaborated at the review of first phase of the #GiveYouthaChance campaign end of January 2017.

Global Challenges Youth Empowerment Partnership GloCha

#GiveYouthaChance is a multistakeholder initiative involving representatives from UNFCCC youth constituency YOUNGO (e.g <u>CliMates</u>), partners from UN system (<u>UNESCO MOST</u>, <u>UN Habitat</u>, <u>UN Women</u>, ...) and other partners (e.g. the <u>Citizens Climate</u> <u>Engagement Network CCEN</u>, <u>WorldWeWant2030</u>, <u>Regional</u> <u>Government of Austrian province of Carinthia</u>, <u>National Youth</u> <u>Authority of Ghana</u> etc.).

For administration of the #GiveYouthaChance campaign and for joint information and resource management there will be set up at COP22 a multistakeholder <u>partnership structure</u> - the <u>Glo</u>bal <u>Cha</u>llenges youth empowerment partnership GloCha - which shall develop into of the world's leading youth focused SDGs delivery mechanism for SDG 10 (reducing inequalities), SDG 11 (sustainable cities and communities), SDG 13 (climate action) and SDG 17 (partnerships).
