

Implementation Plan for pilot projects of Indigenous Redd+

General objective:

Contribute to the **global strategies of mitigation and adaptation to the climate crisis**, strengthening the Amazon biome ecosystem functions through initiatives of Holistic Management of Full Life Territories of Indigenous Peoples, also called, "Indigenous Redd + Amazon ", based on the indigenous peoples' worldviews and rights.

Specific objective:

Strengthening territorial reorganization and consolidation of indigenous peoples, and their management and land management through pilot **implementation of "Indigenous Redd+ Amazon" (RIA) in indigenous territories of at least 4 million hectares of tropical forest in 05 countries (Brazil, Peru, Colombia, Bolivia and Ecuador)** that produce learning, systematize and validation of the proposal and enhance their impact in national and international REDD+ proceses.

1. Socialization and updating of information on REDD + processes at the international, national and subnational level and of the proposed " Holistic Management of Full Life Territories of Indigenous Peoples " or Indigenous REDD+, at local level (pilot experiences) and national indigenous organizations and linked actors (states, international organizations, banks, research organizations, NGOs, etc.).

2. Development and implementation of **Plans of Full Life** of each people and territory involved, differentiating it from the traditional "plans of development or strategy"

3. Baseline on ecosystem functions and balance of the carbon cycle for specific territories, in coordination and consultation with potential financial donors of the pilot projects of Indigenous REDD +.



4. Diagnosis and plans to **reduce the motor (or "drivers") of deforestation and degradation** in indigenous territories involved and its hinterland
5. Developing strategies and tools for **Monitoring, Reporting and Verification (MRV) for Indigenous REDD+**
6. Development of **national REDD+ strategies** to strengthen the Amazon Indigenous Redd+ at local level and specific territories.



7. Development of **appropriate agreements for Indigenous REDD+**, regarding compensations on results for the implementation of the Life Plans that include among others, the community commitments on carbon balance, based on the following considerations:

8. Development of **appropriate financing mechanisms** for the implementation of the Plans of Life Indigenous Amazonian include Redd +

8.1. Evaluation of market **mechanisms outside the carbon credit (offset)** market and no sale of specific carbon credits



8.3. Access of the specific proposals of Indigenous Redd+ to **financial mechanisms existing**, as appropriate to the applicability of every Amazon country:

- Funds and programs of amazon states related to climate, forests and Indigenous Peoples
- **National or sub national government funds** under surveillance of civil society, which redistribute Redd+ resources from various sources.
- Phase of the national readiness plan (RPP) to the FCPF Redd (**Forest Carbon Partnership Facility**)
- Implementation phase of the preparation (Readiness) of Redd of FCPF
- **Green Climate Fund** in the UNFCCC process and especially those related to mitigation and adaptation in the Amazon and for indigenous peoples.



- Phase of carbon investments or payments for results from the FCPF
- UN-REDD Programme's (UNDP, UNEP and FAO)
- **Forest Investment Program (FIP)**
- Dedicated Grant Mechanism for Indigenous Peoples of FIP
- **Brazil's Amazon Fund** supported by Norway
- Low Carbon Fund in Guyana supported by Norway
- Norway International Forestry Initiative (NICFI).
- Andean Amazonian forest program of Finland.
- Environmental Funds and Programs for Forest of the Amazon countries.
- Technical bilateral cooperation regarding climate, environment and forest of Germany (KFW, GIZ), Switzerland (FABU, FOEN), Japan (JICA), United States (USAID), Denmark (DANIDA) and others.



8.4. Development proposals that include **innovative financial mechanisms** to support pilot projects of Amazonian Indigenous REDD+.

- Innovative Funds of compensation / remuneration for PPII by all ecosystem services out of credit markets
- **Multilateral and bilateral cooperation** on adaptation and mitigation of climate change.
- Agreements between European Union and states on forest governance and marketing (**FLEGT mechanism**)
- **Climate bonds of the Amazon states**
- Tax funds to the ecological footprint of international and national companies
- Weather Funds ("**Fair Climate** ") of ICCO and other partners
- **Extension of COICA Trust Fund**
- Channeling philanthropic funds
