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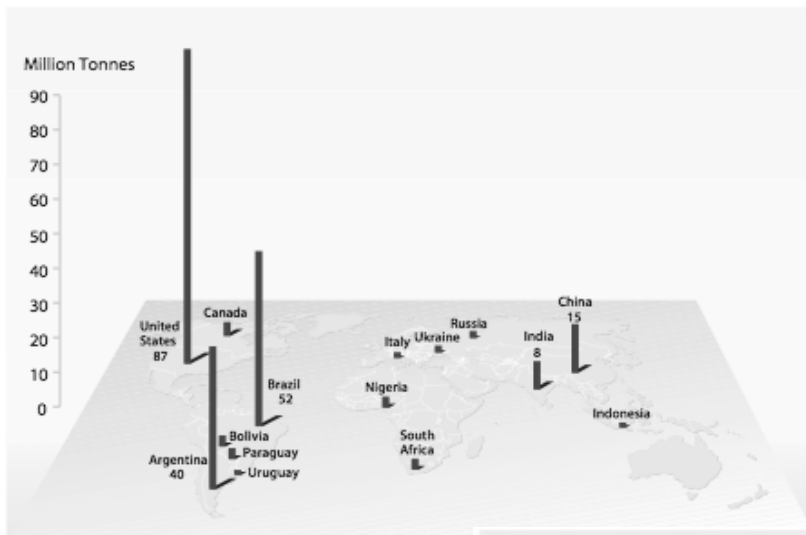

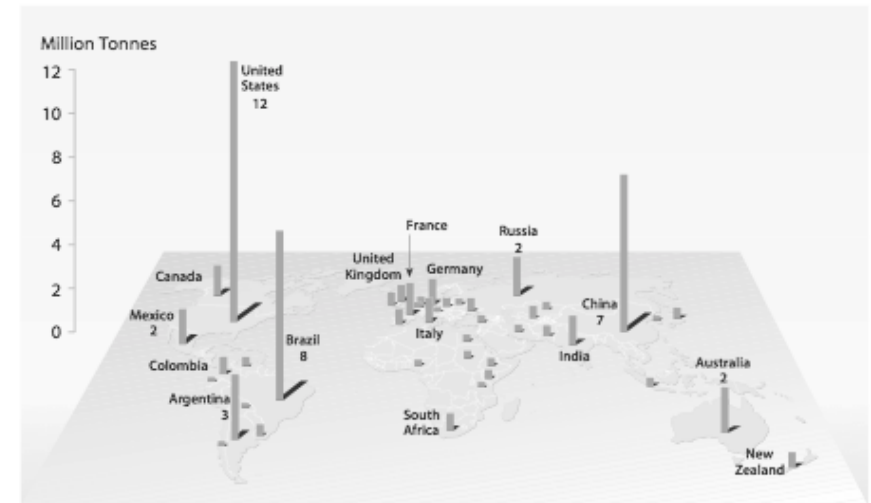

Figure 4.1 Map of Soybean Production by Country, 2006

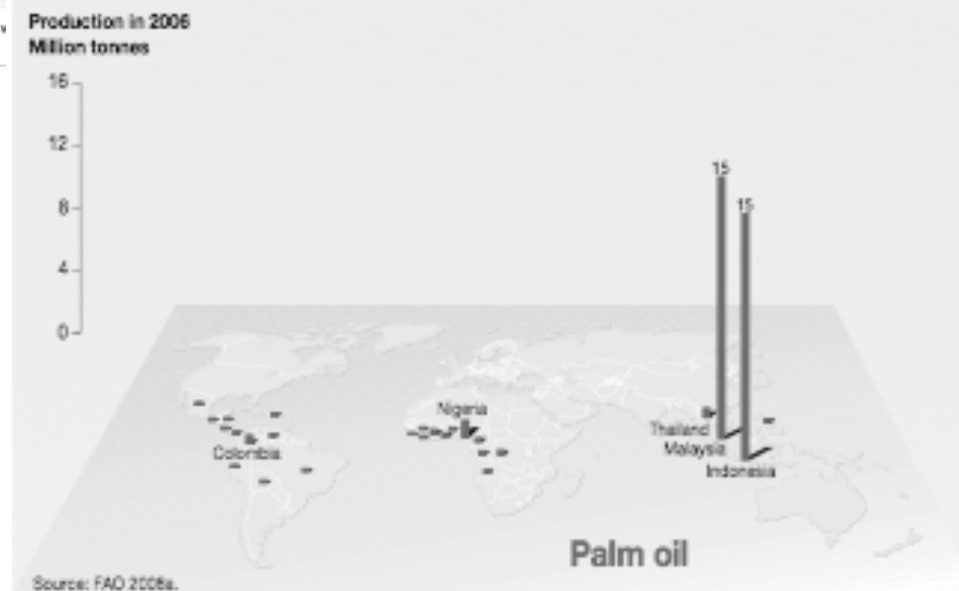
