

Electricity demand coverage (2021)




A fragmented electrical system






Our roadmap: Energy Transition and Climate Change Plan

Reach 2.000 MW in 2033




Reduce 50% our consumption in 2030



First territory in southern Europe to produce green hydrogen for:


- Public transport
