Introducing global mechanisms for measurable, reportable, verifiable local climate action

As of 1 December 2010

Prior to the start of COP16, local governments worldwide moved to the next phase of concrete climate action at the **World Mayors Summit on Climate (WMSC2010) in Mexico City on 21 November 2010**, convened by Mexico City in conjunction with the World Mayors Council on Climate Change (WMCCC), ICLEI – Local Governments for Sustainability and United Cities and Local Governments (UCLG). The Global Cities Covenant on Climate (**the Mexico City Pact**) and **carbonn Cities Climate Registry (cCCR)** are the most concrete outcomes of the WMSC and will be presented in this side event. Local leaders will also present latest positions with regards to UNFCCC/KP negotiations, paying specific attention to the fact that Nations in Nagoya at UNCBD-COP10 recognized and supported local government action by adopting the "**Plan of Action on Subnational Governments, Cities and Other Local Authorities on Biodiversity**". The strong wish for a similar outcome at UNFCCC COP16 will be addressed.
