

More than a decade after the adoption of the Warsaw Framework for REDD+, the landscape of REDD+ implementation is becoming increasingly complex...




# What we have now: REDD+ Discussion Forum

- Land area representation;
- Carbon stock changes;
- Sampling strategy & statistics.

## What we have now: REDD+ reviews

Technical assessment of proposed FRELs/FRLs and technical analysis of REDD+ results is a good opportunity to have direct interaction between experts and REDD+ countries.

#### What are the benefits of REDD+ review?

REDD+ review processes
enhance country's capacity
to report GHG emissions
and removals in the forest
sector, helping to build trust
and enabling them to track
progress towards
achieving NDCs.

Using the insights gained from the REDD+ review, countries increase their domestic long-term capacity to gather and analyze data, which in turn helps to inform policy decisions and implement more ambitious climate action in the forest sector.

#### **Global meeting**


Holding one global meeting every two years, bringing together REDD+ experts from all regions, key donors and observer organizations for open and inclusive exchange.
