What is CTI PFAN?

The CTI Private Financing Advisory Network (CTI PFAN) is a multilateral, public-private partnership that nurtures promising, innovative clean energy projects by bridging the gap between investors and clean energy entrepreneurs and businesses.

CTI PFAN brings together private-sector companies with experience in financing climate-friendly business to screen business plans and select the most economically viable and environmentally beneficial projects. For those entrepreneurs and businesses selected, PFAN provides guidance on overall project structure and business plans, feasibility studies and introductions to investors.

CTI PFAN's goals are to accelerate technology transfer and diffusion under the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), reduce greenhouse gas emissions, promote low-carbon, sustainable economic development, and help facilitate the transition to a low-carbon economy by increasing the financing opportunities for promising clean energy projects. CTI PFAN accomplishes this by building a network of investors, entrepreneurs, technical experts and government representatives with a common goal of increasing the viability of clean and renewable energy.

CTI PFAN is supported in Asia by the Climate Technology Initiative (CTI), the US Agency for International Development (USAID) and the International Center for Environmental Technology Transfer (ICETT).

The CTI PFAN Network in Asia

CTI PFAN started operations in Asia in early 2009 and quickly established a regional network, covering South East Asia as well as dedicated country networks in China, India, Indonesia and the Philippines. It is envisaged that PFAN activities and networks in Asia will be further expanded from 2012.

CTI PFAN's regional and in-country networks are actively seeking new network members and projects for the development pipeline. CTI PFAN Clean Energy Financing Forum in Asia

CTI PFAN Asia organizes Clean Energy Financing Forums in the region on a regular basis; these include regional forums and dedicated country events to showcase mature investment grade projects to potential investors. For information on upcoming forum events visit www.cti-pfan.net.

CTI PFAN Success in Asia

In Asia, 9 Forums have been organized including 2 Asia Regional Forums and 7 Country Forums in the Philippines, Indonesia, China and India.

As of June 2011, over 100 clean energy projects have been mentored and presented to investors in Asia through the PFAN process, of which 21 have achieved financial closure with US\$274.6 million of investment being raised. These projects include biogas, biomass, waste-to-energy, solar, small hydro and energy efficiency initiatives.

Combined, these 21 projects will mitigate over 12.2 million metric tons of CO₂ over the lifetime of the projects, the equivalent of taking more than 2.4 million cars off the road for one year.
