




# In 2015 the NYDF Assessment started monitoring progress towards the ten goals of the New York Declaration on Forests















### Enable accountability: the Forest Declaration Assessment Partners


















































# From 2015 - 2022 we have published eight flagship reports focusing on major forest themes




### Trends towards 2030 forest goals are not encouraging

#### Goals (not achieved):


- Halting deforestation & degradation
- Restoring 350 million hectares of landscapes
- Eliminating deforestation from commodity supply chains
- Adopting and implementing mandates for forest protection
- Aligning national development and environment priorities
- Shifting finance from grey to green

Global deforestation decreased in 2021, but not fast enough
