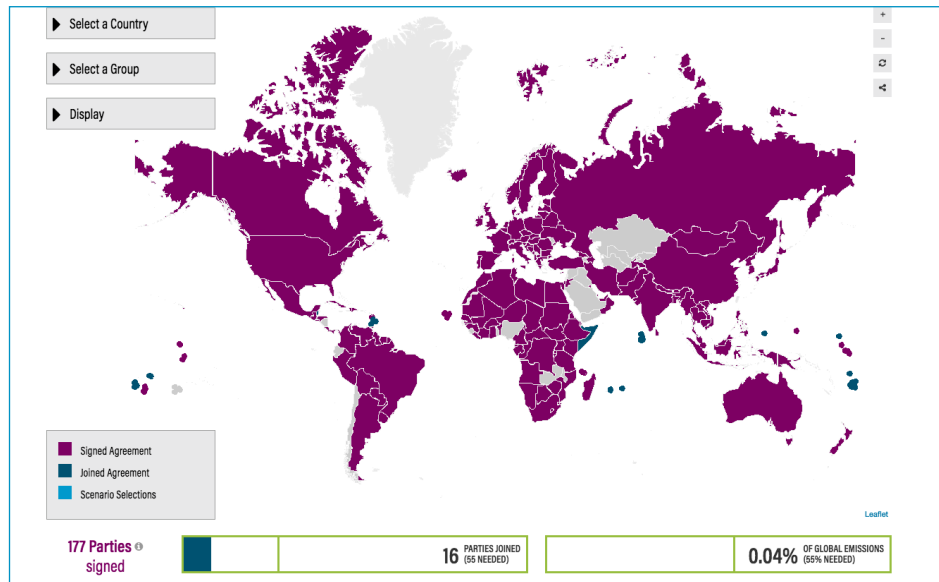
## Introducing the Paris Agreement Tracker

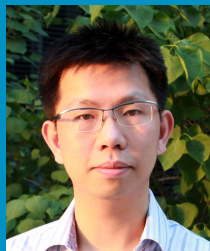
