### What is an ITMO?

- ITMO is an offset = authorized mitigation outcome in tCO2eq or non-GHG metric
- An ITMO can be tracked as:
  - A serialized **unit** issued for a mitigation outcome
    - In a transactional registry
  - A record of a serialized amount used to account for an underling unit issued for a mitigation outcome in another account of the same or another registry
    - In a non-transaction registry

An ITMO maybe bound to an underlying MO unit in a permanent one-to one relationship.

ITMOs bound to MOs cannot be transferred. The MOs can be transferred and the ITMOs reflect the transfers.
