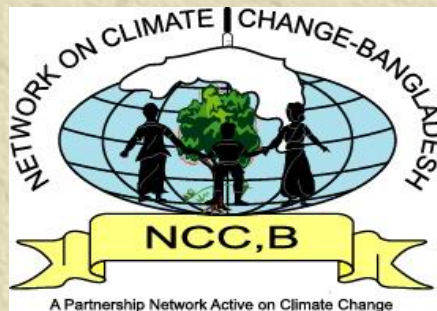

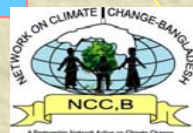

Background of NCC,B

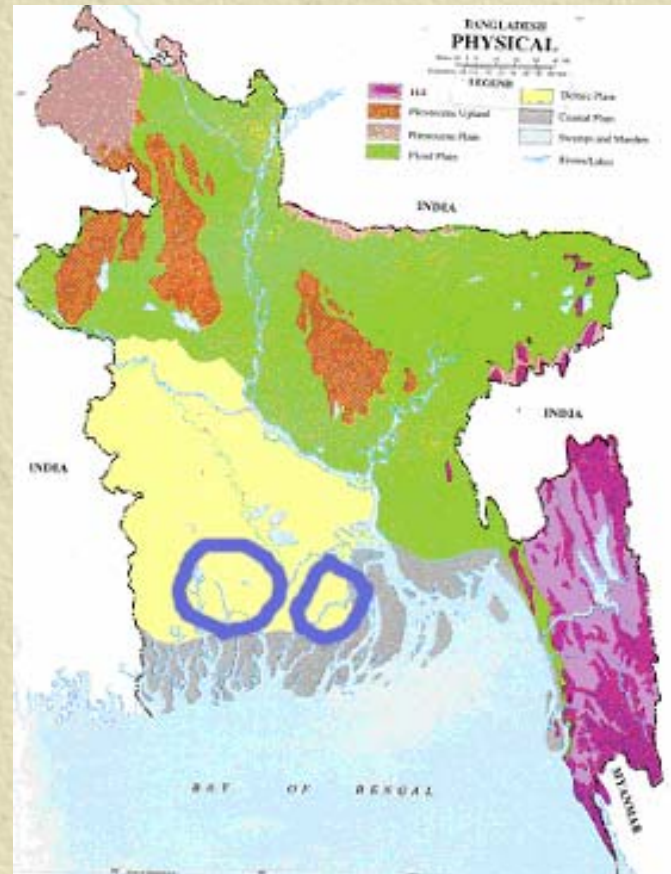
✪ The adverse effect of climate change (cc) is now an increasing reality for the people of Bangladesh, especially in the coastal zone. But till to date it is an agenda limited to top-level development discourses, little is shared with the victims. The poor with resource constraint will not be able to cope with the adverse changes.

✪ In response to the situation three partner NGOs jointly initiated a network to work mainly in the south-west coastal region of Bangladesh, under the lead of PRODIPAN



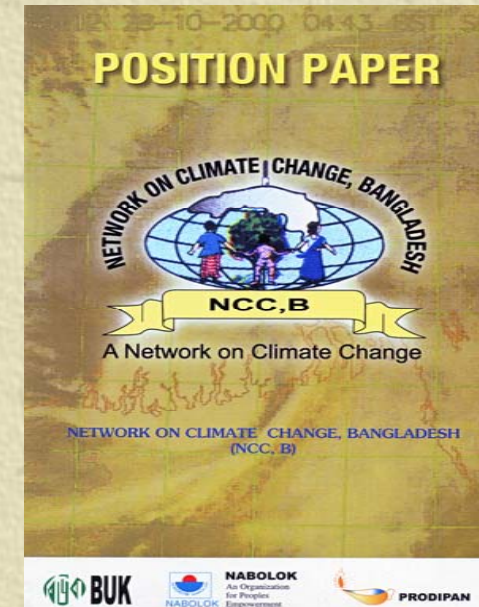
Working Area of NCC,B

Khulna, Bagerhat & Barisal- 3 coastal districts of Bangladesh are the working area of the Network.



Position of the Network

- ✠ The Network starts with 3 founder Organizations, and has a plan to include new Associate Members.
- ✠ Three partner NGOs of NCC,B came to a resolution that the issue of cc should be in the main stream of the organization and it should be incorporated in all the projects.
- ✠ One Position paper on NCC,B activities has been prepared, published & distributed.
- ✠ One secretariat and 3 Climate Change Corners have been established in three partner organizations head office.



The Network partners are now implementing 2 projects

- Campaign on Climate Change, Bangladesh (CCC,B)
- Disaster Prevention in the Context on Climate Change (DPCC).

Goal & Objectives of CCC,B

✧ Over all Goal/Overall Objective

Initiate actions at community people, opinion leaders, national policy makers and cross national policy makers to restrict basic causes of climate change and coping with climate change related vulnerabilities.

✧ **Objective-1:** Awareness raising of the community people about climate change.

✧ **Objective-2:** Awareness raising of the local opinion leaders on climate change.

✧ **Objective-3:** Lobby & advocacy among the political decision makers on climate change.

✧ **Objective-4:** Lobby & advocacy in international forum.

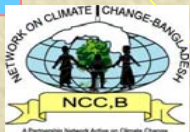

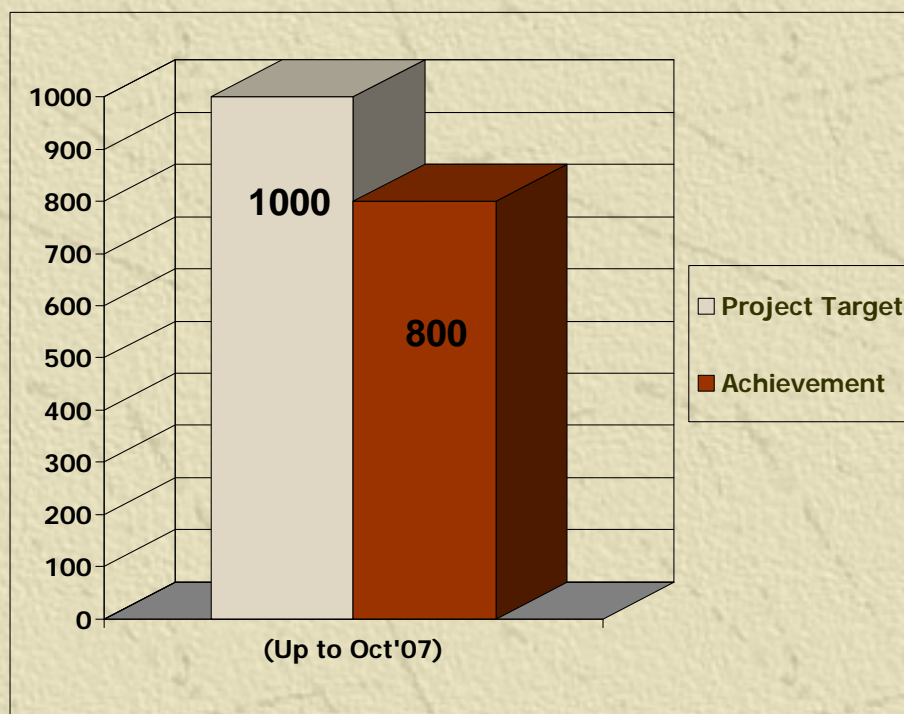

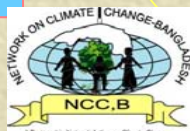


Audiovisual (multimedia) show for the student

2 issues have been selected

- Incorporation of CC in the election manifesto of the political parties (held up, due to emergency)
- Advocacy for ensuring human rights & compensation for the Climate Refugees.

NCC,B also published the SPM of WG 1 & 3 of the IPCC AR4 report in Bangle and chapter 10 , 'Asia' of WG 2 is under process.

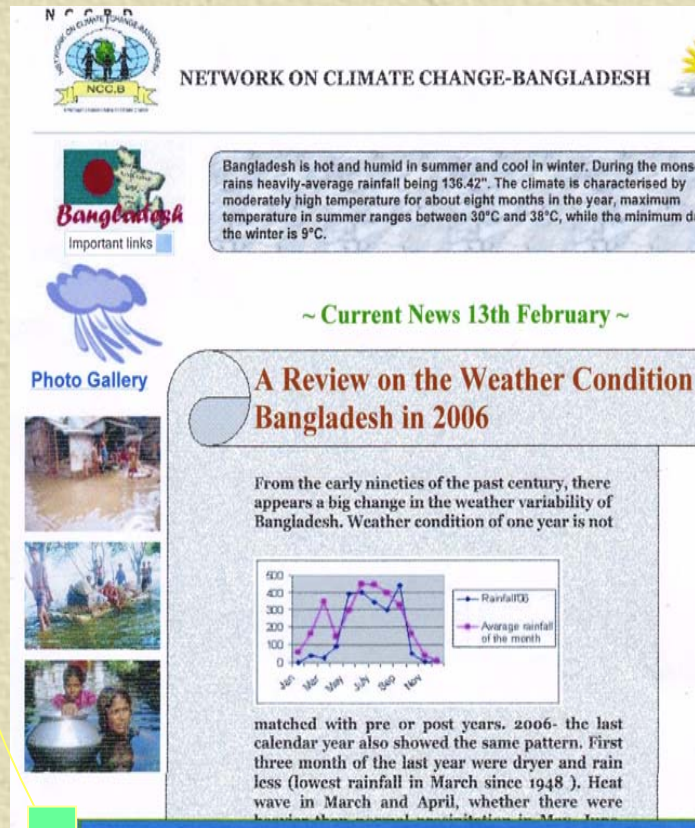
Network partners also organized Public Rallis in different level.

Website Hosting

NCC,B has hosted a web site www.nccbd.org. The impact of Climate Change and the most vulnerable sectors of Bangladesh are mainly focused in the site. The website is also updated with Various types of weather data.



Data Bank

NCC,B has developed a data bank where one can get rainfall and temperature data of last 50 years of Bangladesh.

NCC,B Project 2: Disaster Prevention in the context of Climate Change (DPCC) Project

Goal

Enhancement of the capacity of poor communities at the coastal areas of Southwest and middle coast to encounter disasters related to climate change

Objective-1. Creation of an effective wind barrier around houses that can withstand wind speed of 100-150 Km per hour

Objective-2. Fortification of house to make them Cyclone and Tidal surge proof

Objective-3. Community capacity building for retaining seed after climate change related disasters

Objective-4. Flood shelter for people, cattle and supply of sweet water



achievements...

4800 households were selected to provide Coconut and Guava saplings to protect house from strong wind/storm.

Out of 52,500 targeted saplings, 40,700 were properly distributed, planted and made fencing .

1250 households were selected for house-fortification and 625 house fortified.



- Flood shelters and seed stores are under process.
- Land was selected for pond excavation.
- 17 youth brigade will be formed in 17 villages.
