Title: Maximizing the value of the CDM pre-2020

Description: With almost 8.000 CDM projects and close to 300 PoAs, CDM represents a

unique ready-to-go mitigation opportunity. The mechanism and its infrastructure is accessible

to all, whether for voluntary purposes, compliance purposes or simply as a robust monitoring,

reporting and verification tool for climate action.

With the Paris Agreement, Parties agreed to ramp-up their climate action with the objective

to hold the increase in global average temperature below 2°C above pre-industrial levels.

Nevertheless, increased climate action before 2020 is urgently needed given the current trend

in greenhouse gases emissions and to build a solid foundation for even greater action after

2020. In this context, Parties highlighted at COP21 the use of the CDM to enhance mitigation

action prior to 2020.

This side event explores ideas for ensuring that CDM projects and PoAs can continue to deliver

real on-the-ground mitigation, and help increasing ambition under the Paris Agreement
