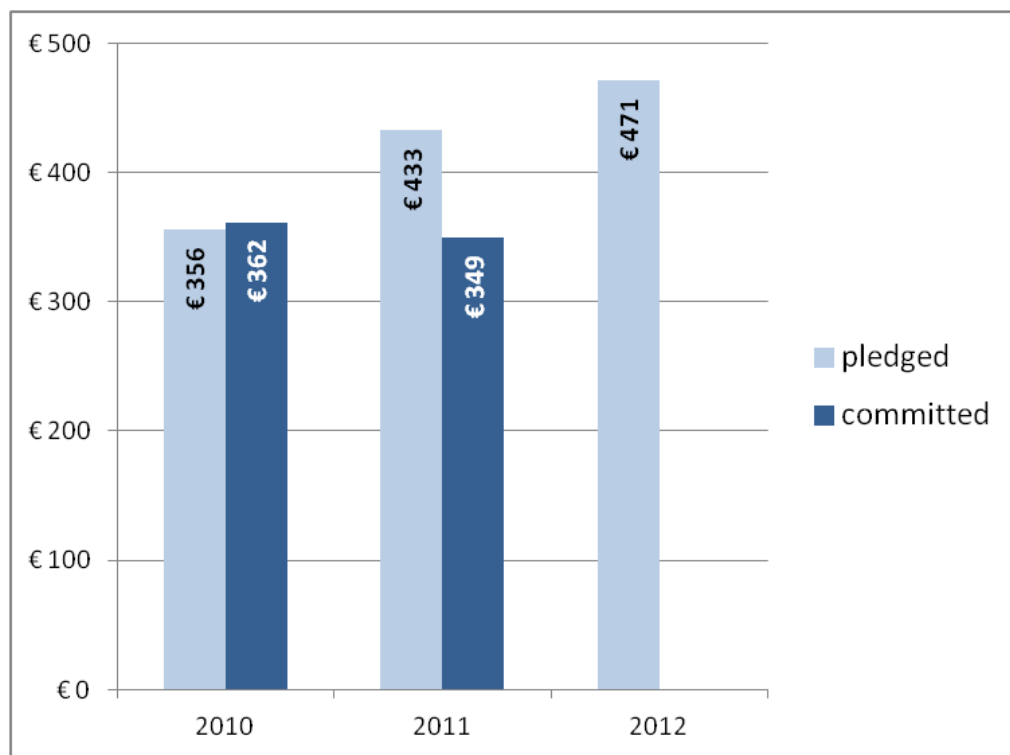

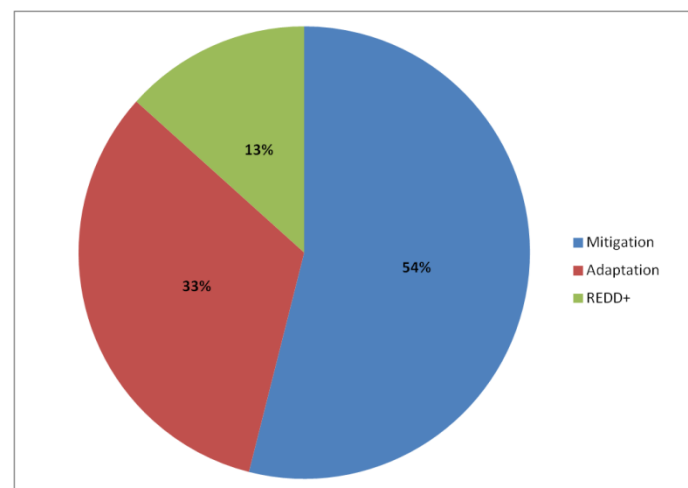
German fast start commitment

As at November 2011

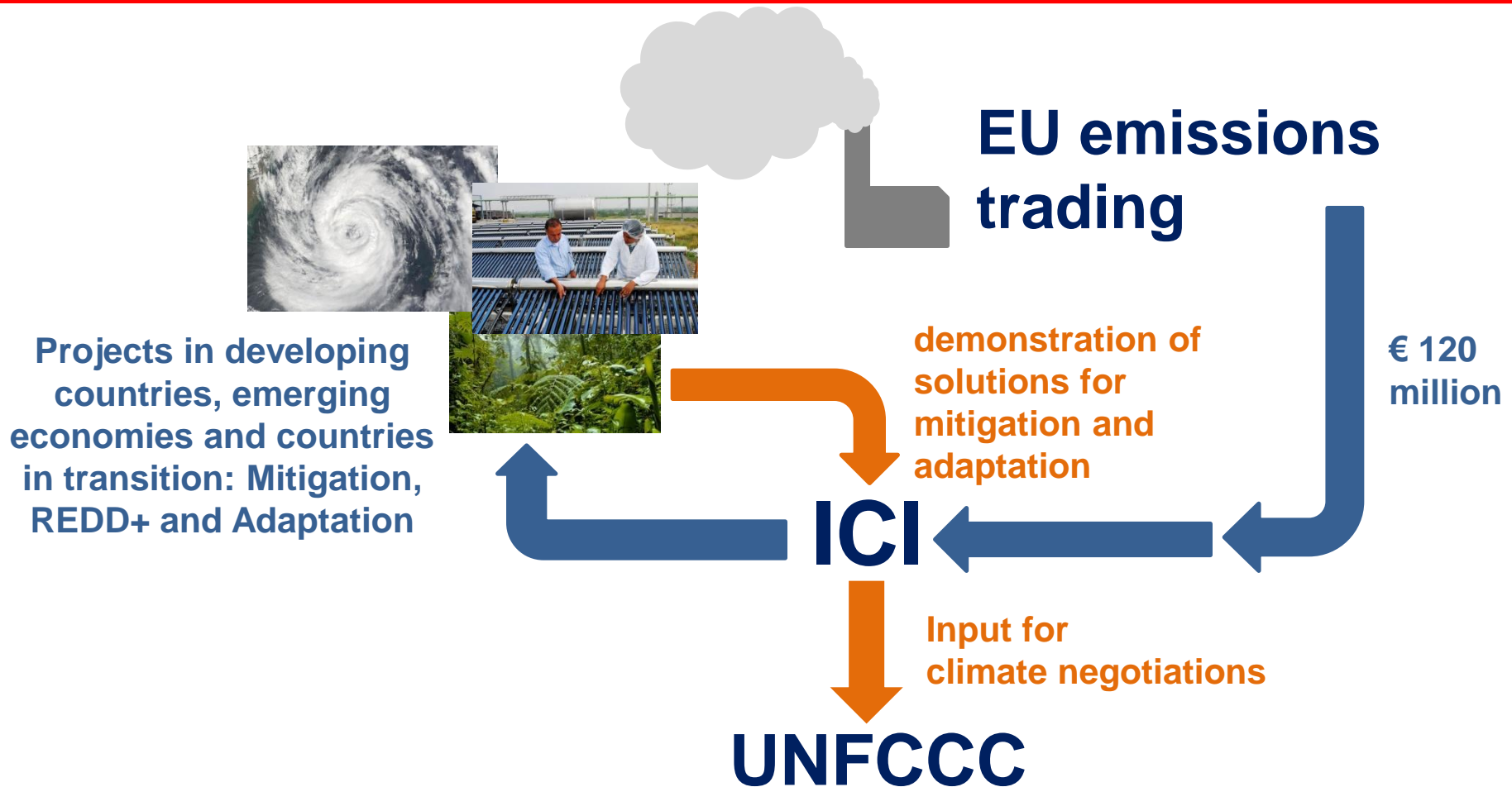
Allocation on Germany's fast start contribution (in %)

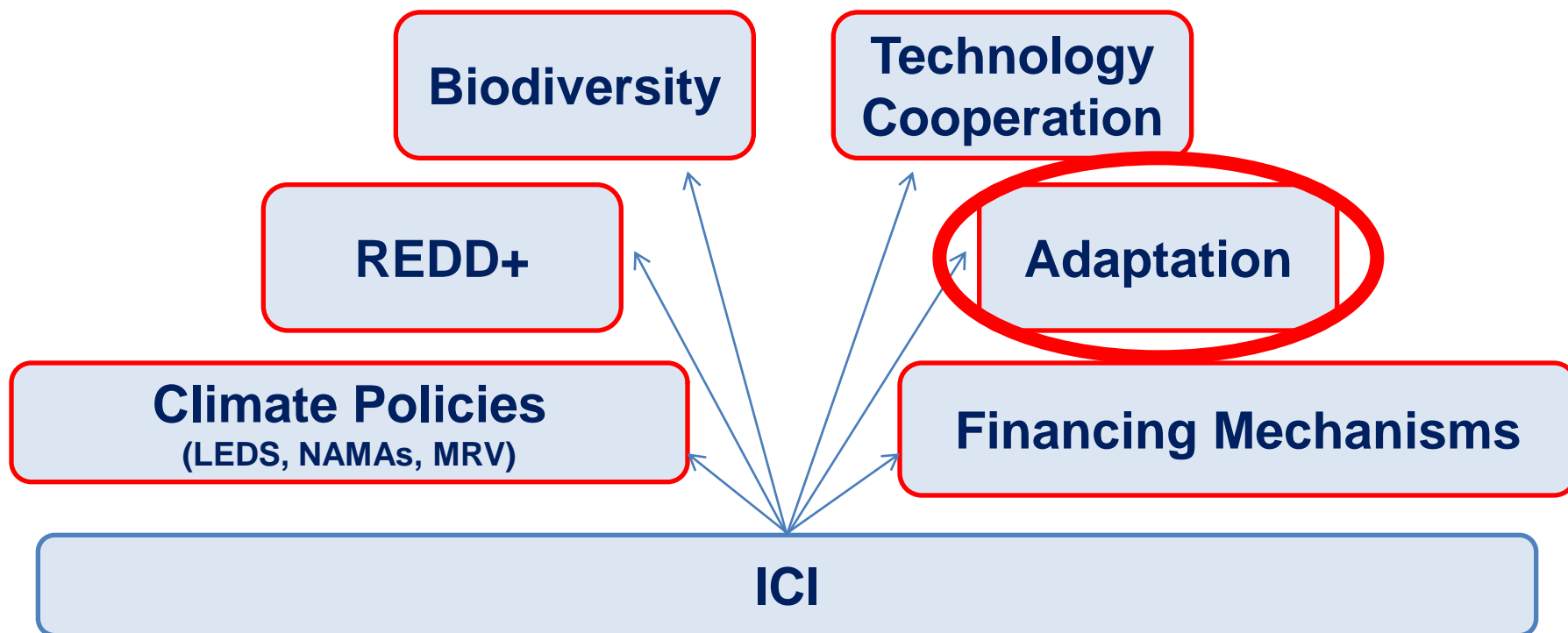
ICI - The International Climate Initiative





ICI - The target: support the addressing of climate actions

Supporting developing countries, emerging economies and countries in transition in addressing climate action and thereby a legally binding comprehensive climate agreement, through a project based approach focusing on:





ICI – Adaptation to climate change

- 2008 until January 2011: Funding 220 projects with total amount of **€ 462 million**
 - Mobilising of additional capital (implementing agencies + other public and private-sector sources): **€ 788 million**
 - **€ 1.250 billion** total funding volume of ICI projects
 - Adaptation: 42 projects, total amount of € 72 million
 - Adaptation “in pipeline”: 15 projects, total amount of € 50 million
- ⇒ ICI Adaptation: € 122 million
(2008 – 2017; disbursed and committed)



ICI insurance projects

Innovative insurance approaches

- Implemented in Peru, Kenya, Ghana, Vietnam and China by various implementing agencies (SNV, GIZ)
- **MCII project in the Caribbean**

=> pilots that support the development of insurance solutions as part of integrated adaptation strategies



ICI insurance projects

- Develop insurance products **appropriate for and accepted by communities**
- Enable **access** to these products for vulnerable communities
- Move from strategies to **viable insurance solutions implemented** as part of adaptation actions
- Provide incentives for **preventive measures and, thus, trigger adaptation**
- Offer products to be **picked up by the market and engage the private sector in scaling-up**

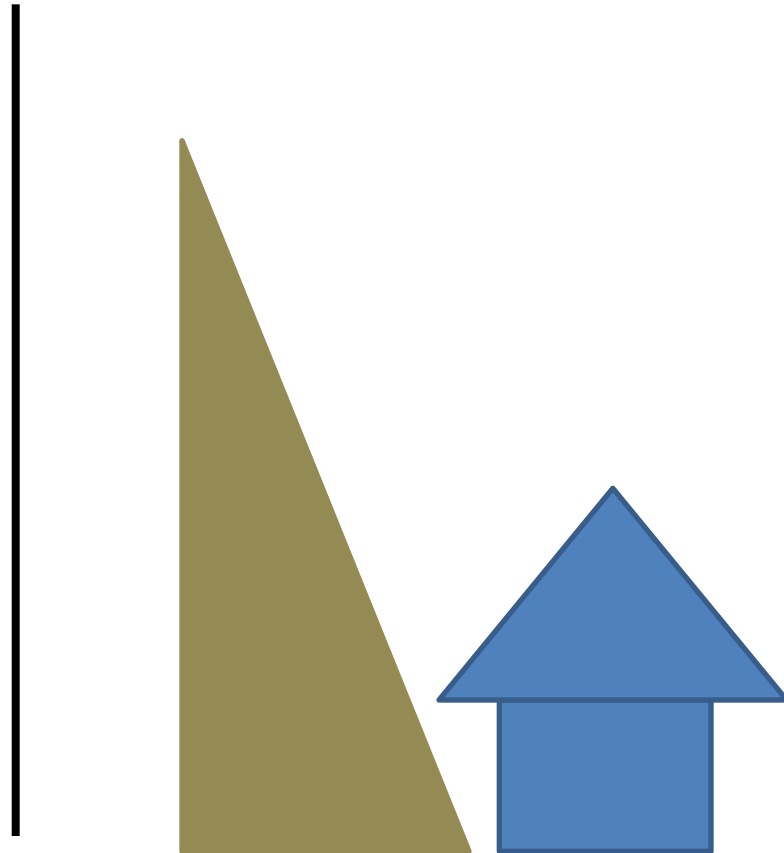
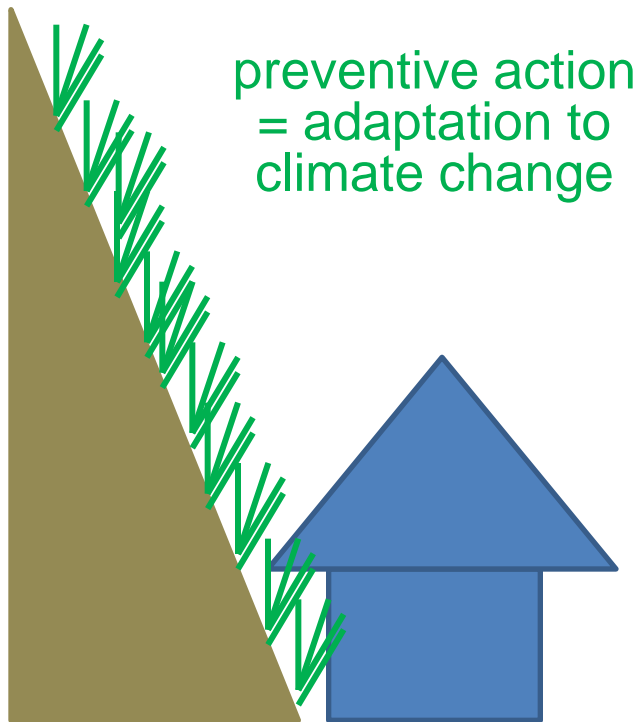
