SOLAR COOKERS INTERNATIONAL (SCI) BRINGS URGENT SOLUTION TO UNITED NATIONS CLIMATE CONFERENCE (COP28)

SACRAMENTO, CA, USA (17 November 2023) -- Solar Cookers International (SCI) will champion solar cooking solutions at the upcoming Conference of Parties to the United Nations Convention on Climate Change (COP28) in Expo City, Dubai, United Arab Emirates, 30 November -12 December 2023.

The simplest solar cooker can save a family from burning one tonne of wood in a year, and with approximately 2.4 billion people worldwide cooking over open fires, solar thermal cooking is a powerful and appropriate solution.

"Climate change is an urgent issue," said Caitlyn Hughes, Executive Director of Solar Cookers International. "The time for action is now. Solar cooking is an ideal solution to both mitigate and adapt to climate change."

Solar cookers aid in addressing a key driver of climate change by reducing carbon pollution and replacing the need to source wood for fires. It is estimated that over 30 million metric tons of CO₂ emissions are prevented over the lifetime of the world's solar cookers. These emissions are equal to not driving over 76 billion miles or not burning over 34 billion pounds of coal.

SCI is urging governments to use solar cooking in their Nationally Determined Contributions and Voluntary National Reviews as part of their climate policymaking, monitoring, and reporting activities through the United Nations.
