## IPCC SIDE EVENT ON THE OUTCOMES OF THE IPCC WORKSHOP ON THE USE OF SCENARIOS IN AR6 AND SUBSEQUENT ASSESSMENTS

## June 9th 10:15-11:30

Scenarios play a critical role in climate research and assessments. Building on the IPCC workshop, their use, further developments and innovation will be discussed, as well as links with scientific, user and stakeholder communities to support and inform their use in future assessments. The IPCC does not produce its own scenarios, it only assesses scenarios available in the underlying literature.

The IPCC Workshop, held in Bangkok from 25-27 April 2023, aimed to evaluate the scientific approaches and institutional processes that link the relevant scientific communities to future IPCC assessments. The workshop brought together 93 experts from diverse domains, including modelers, scenario builders, and users from across the climate change scientific domains, as well as disciplinary experts with cross-cutting expertise, and scenario users from governments and other stakeholder groups.
