




Report on the Achievements of the CDM (CDM Executive Board)

- Role of the CDM in national carbon pricing schemes (e.g. China, Korea, Colombia, South Africa)
- New departments and renewable energy regulations





How does the CDM stimulate investments?

Increasing the return on investments

Impact varies largely from a few % points in the IRR to fully financing the investment, depending on technology and price of the CER

Upfront finance offered by many carbon buyers (e.g. up to 30% of ERPA value)

Currency: Carbon finance is paid in US\$ or € and used as a currency hedge





How does the CDM stimulate investments?

Diligent MRV of emission reductions and involvement of international partners paves the way for more investments

Result-based payments lowers the risk for financiers

Joint ventures between local project developers and international carbon market developers

Dedicated Funds: Large amount of finance made available in carbon funds (e.g. World Bank)



The CDM achieved its results in the US\$ 5-15 price range!

Carbon-price level consistent with achieving the Paris temperature target:

At least *US\$40*— *US\$50*—100 80 per tCO2 by per tCO2 by 2020 2030


