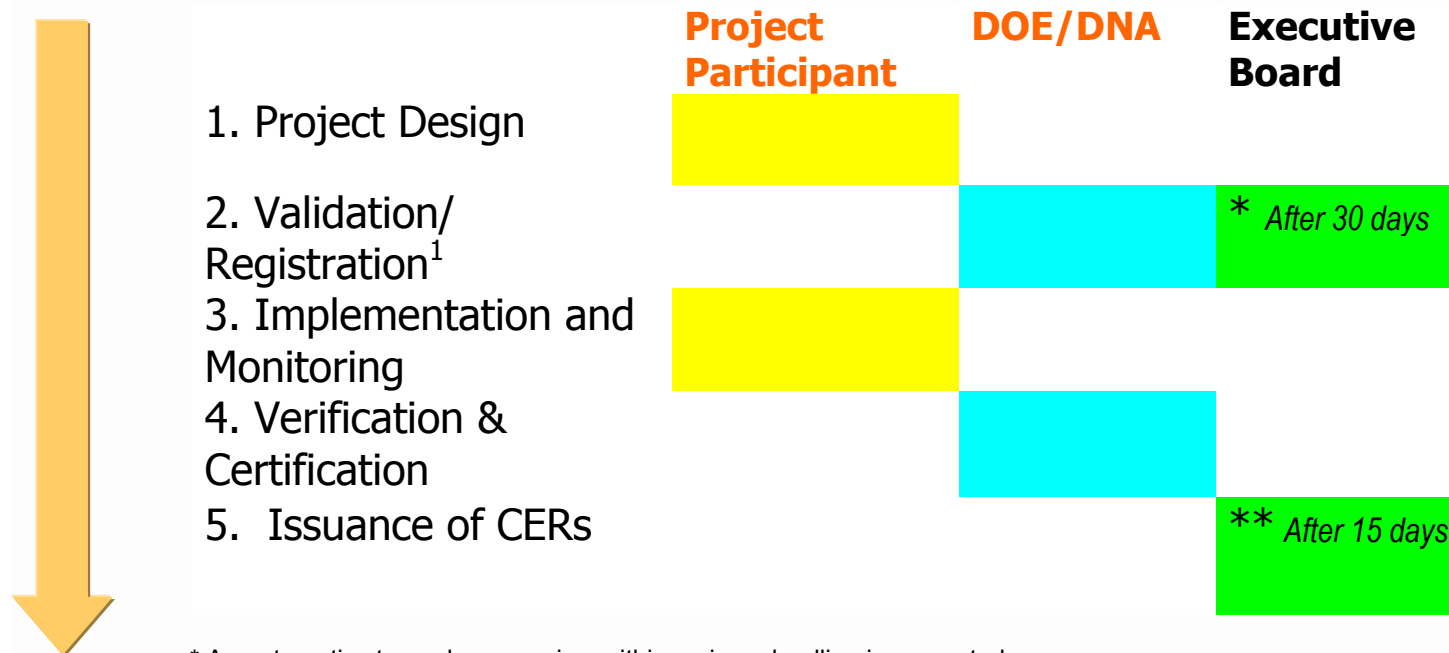

# CDM Project Cycle – actors & steps

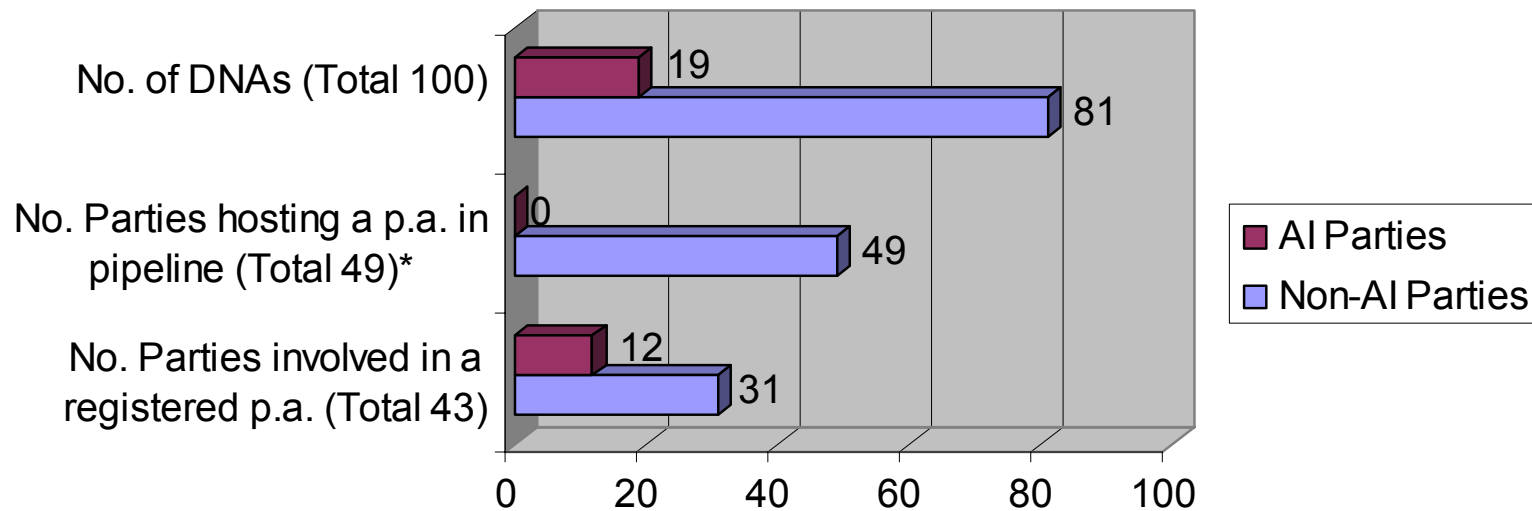

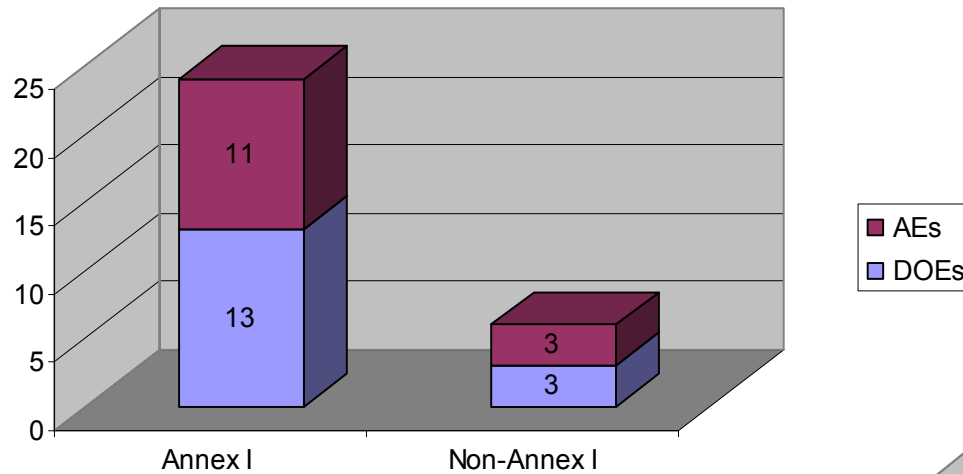

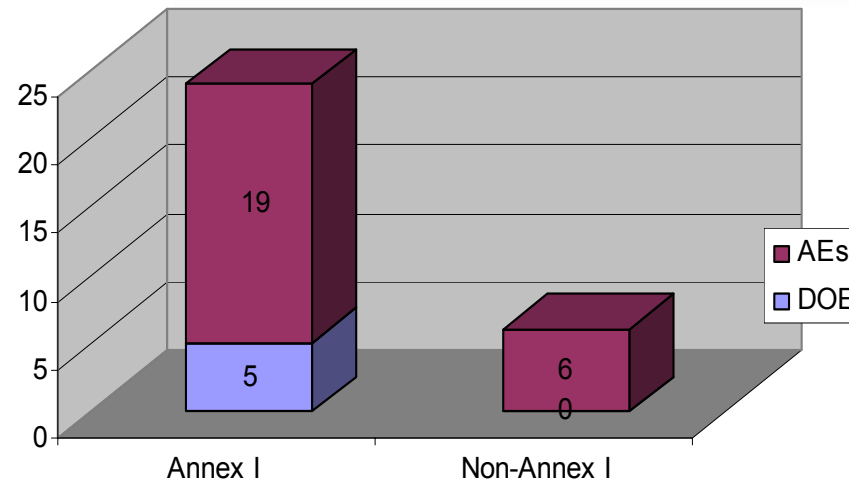

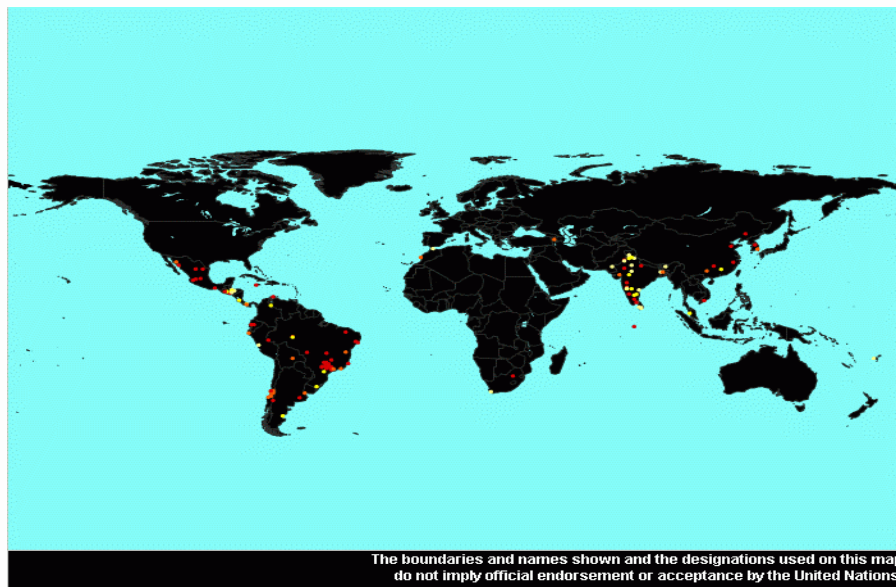

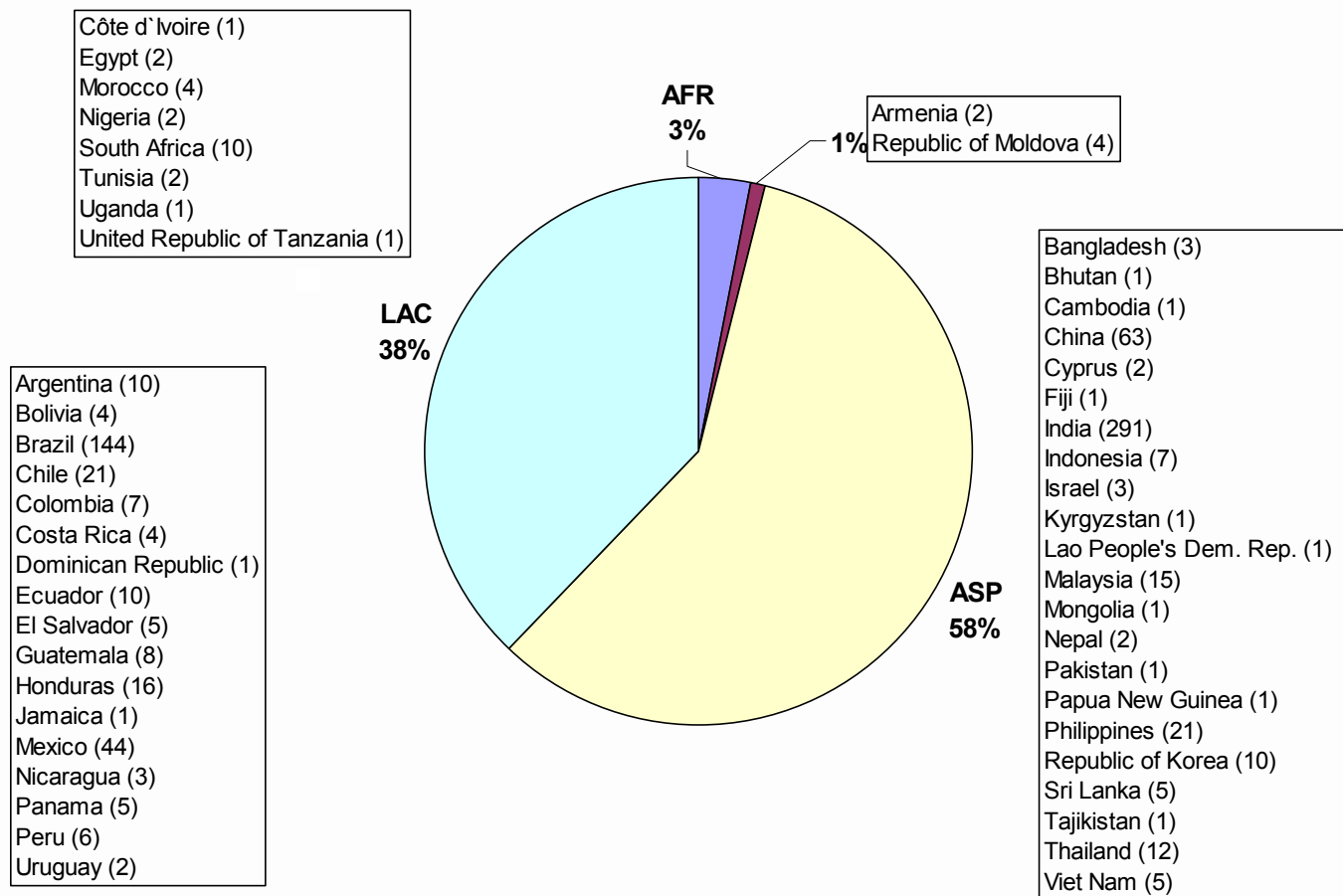

# Score Board: CDM

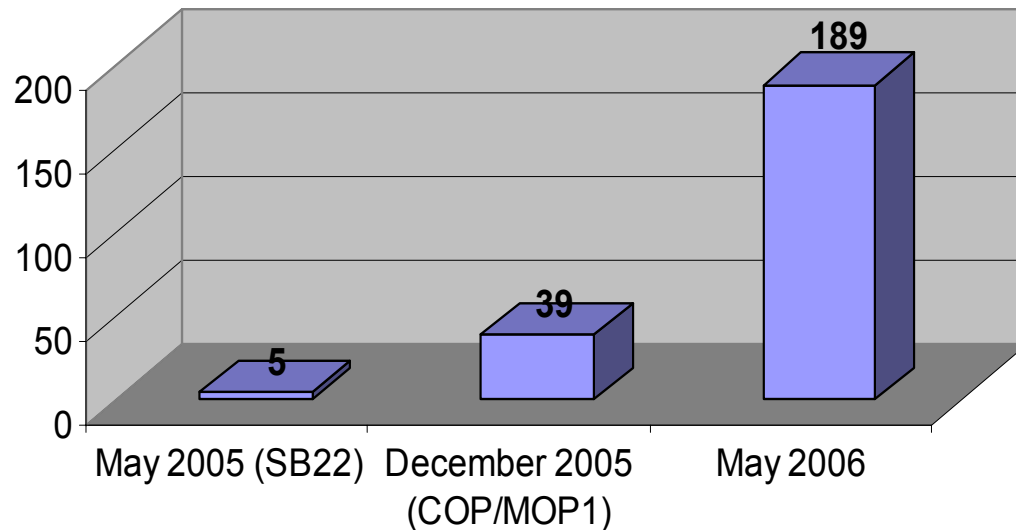


**More than 760 activities in the CDM pipeline**

## Evolution of no. of registrations over one year

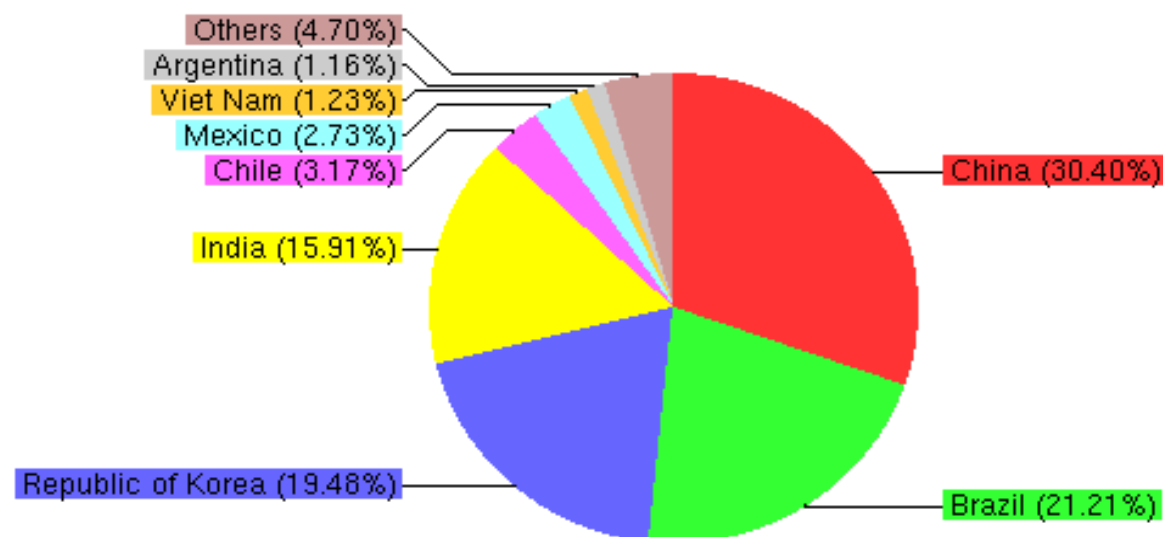


**189 CDM project activities,**

# Expected average CERs from registered projects by host country

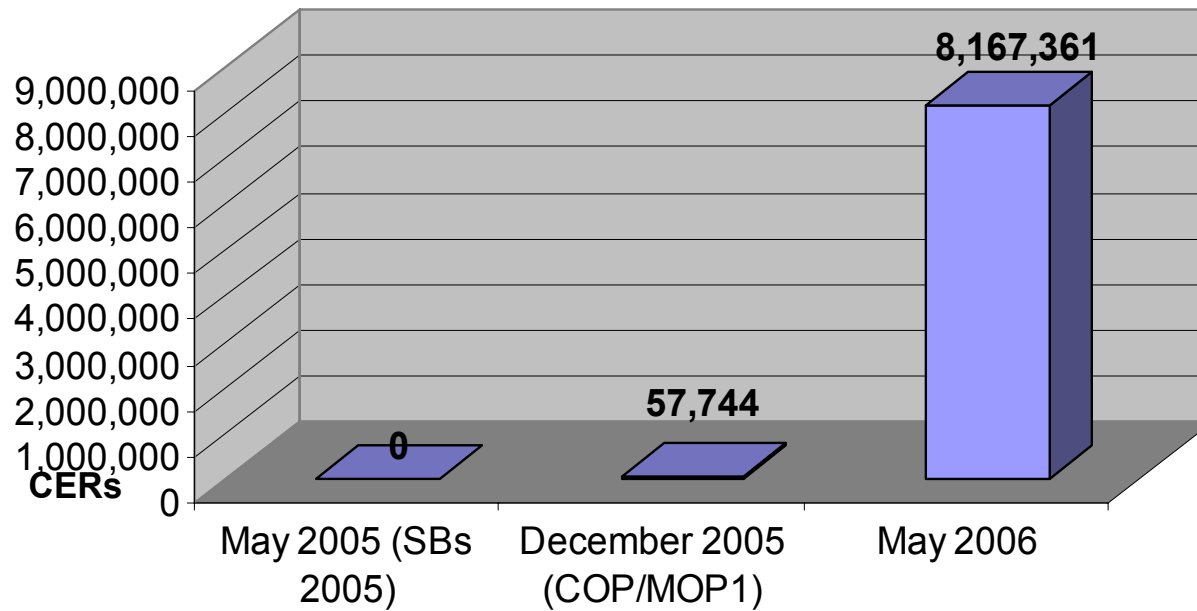
Expected average annual CERs from registered projects by host party. Total: 54,912,347



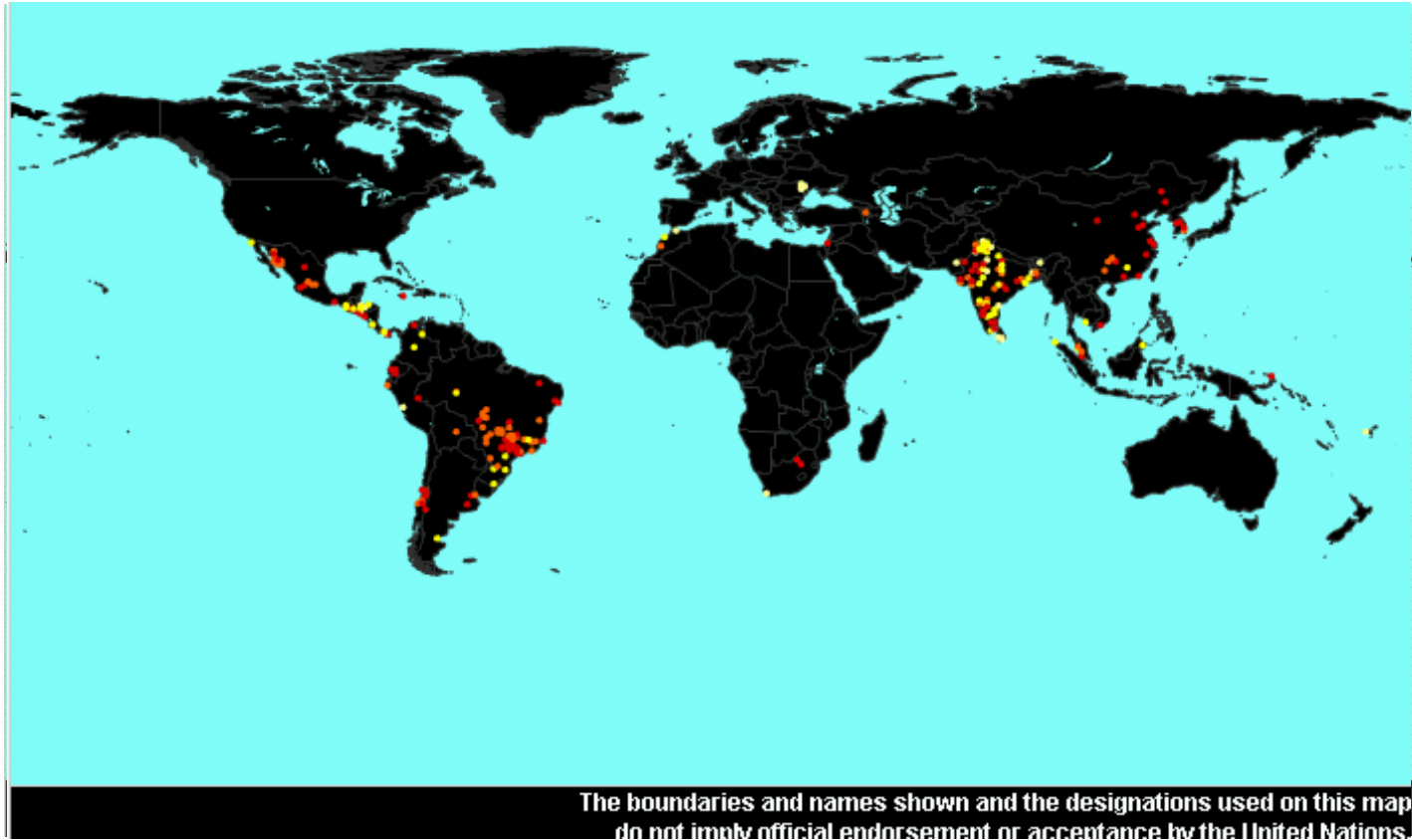
