



Timeline of NAP and NDC processes

2017

- Climate risk assessment (NAP)
- Revision of planning guidelines to integrate adaptation (NAP)
- Elaboration of investment plan and roadmap for NDC

2015

 COP in Paris: decision on NDC elaboration

2016

- Launch of NAP process
- Validation of NAP roadmap
- Submission of provisory NDC

2018

- Elaboration of private sector stratégy, MRV-system (NDC)
- Fusion of NDC and NAP roadmaps






Success factors

- No additional institutional architecture was created for the NAP process

 tight management structure








Success factors

- Overlapping activities have been merged








Success factors
