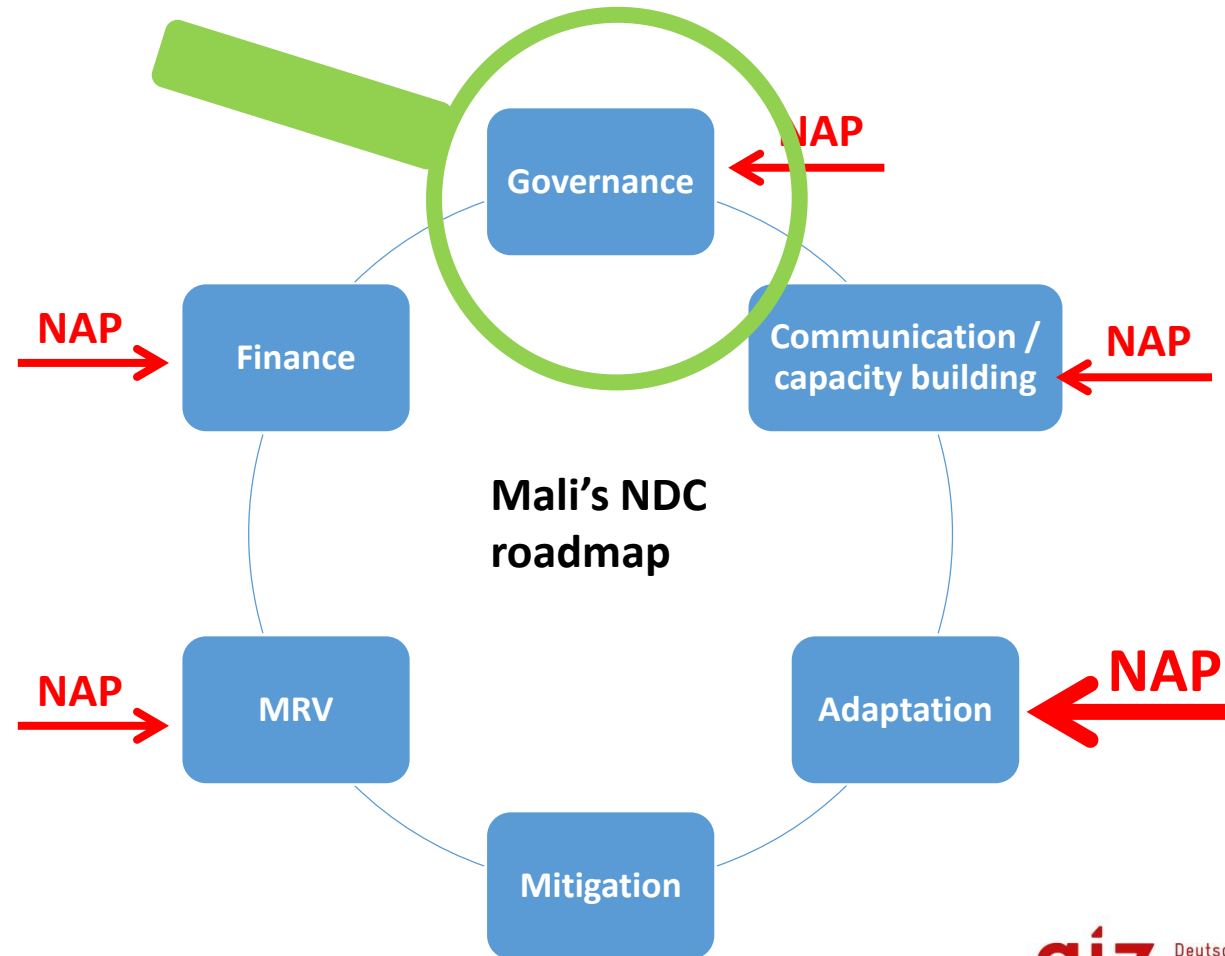

# Integration of NAP and NDC process





## Success factors

- Management of both processes coordinated by the same institutions → national climate change council supervises while AEDD executes
- No additional institutional architecture was created for the NAP process → tight management structure





## Success factors

- Both roadmaps conceived as working documents → continuously evolving
- Integration of NAP activities in **all** pillars of NDC process (except mitigation)
- Overlapping activities have been merged







## Success factors

- Support from NDC-Partnership (WRI and GIZ) helped to dynamise the processes
