KEY POINTS

- 1.5°C impossible with food and agriculture business as usual (BAU)
- Diets and demand-side interventions essential
- Public procurement and emerging new protein economy offer excellent opportunities
- NDCs with robust food/ag targets, including shifting diets away from animal-based foods (especially in over-consuming populations), promote food security and have co-benefits for public health, forests, biodiversity, and more

ACTIONS NEEDED

- Develop national guidelines for sustainable and healthy diets
- End incentives and subsidies enabling BAU; redirect funds to produce low-GHG foods
- Multi-stakeholder collaboration in both the short and long terms
- UNFCCC provide technical assistance for parties to integrate food/ag effectively into NDCs
- Absolute emissions reductions in livestock sector
