Approaches

- Establishment of sector specific ICCs and working groups
- Use of common information exchange portal
- Regular technical report sharing (quarterly) documenting best practices with collaborating partners and participating community units (WHO, Districts, Media, ICCs)

Lessons

- Information sharing amongst stakeholders builds confidence in the management of country coordination strategies
- Creates long-term working relationships
- Demystifies assumed bottlenecks
- Leverages resources and comparative advantage amongst partners

Challenges

- Variance in stakeholder strength and influence
 - Financing levels and conditions
 - Annual budget cycles and funding mechanisms amongst organizations
 - Changing global agenda (WHA outcomes such as transitioning to NCDs)
 - M & E integration
 - Duplication of activities
